On Saturday, January 18th, 2025 at approximately 10:47 PM, we conducted a License Premise Check at the address of 2573 N Vel R Phillips Ave (City and County of Milwaukee).

Upon entry of the business, we were met by a bartender identified as Dana L BROWN Jr. BROWN stated he is a bartender at the location and spoke to us regarding the business. BROWN stated his mother owned the bar.

Interview of Dana BROWN (Bartender):

BROWN stated they are open 6 days a week (Closed on Monday's)- 7 PM- Bar Close all days except 4 PM- Bar Close.

BROWN stated the security cameras are only inside and only his mother has access to them. BROWN stated they only have unarmed security for some events and the last one was New Year's Eve. BROWN stated they have a zero tolerance for any bad behavior.

The business appeared to be clean.

BROWN was very cooperative with us.

I observed licenses posted, but not valid. On the City of Milwaukee License Search, the business has valid licenses. I informed BROWN of the situation and he called his mother/owner Valerie WINGO. I spoke to WINGO who stated she was out of town, but would ensure they would get posted once she arrives back in town.

This report is written by Police Officer Luis MENDOZA, assigned to District Five, Late Power Shift.

On Wednesday, April 9th, 2025, at approximately 22:51, squad 5428 (P.O. Kyle LABENSKY and I) was dispatched to 2573 N Vel R Phillips Ave (BETTIE'S & EDDIE'S CLUB MANHATTAN), located in the City and County of Milwaukee, to a Battery complaint. We were both in full duty uniform, operating a fully marked Milwaukee Police Department squad car, and equipped with Axon body worn cameras.

Squad 5230 (P.O. REEL, DEANGELO & P.O. THOMPSON, JOSHUA) and squad 5291 (P.O.KEOVILAY , SISOUPHANH) also responded and assisted with the investigation.

Upon arrival, I observed multiple subjects leaving/dispersing from the bar. I also observed squad 5230 and 5291 already on scene. We were not flagged down by anyone and **were unable to find a victim/complainant.**

I spoke to the owner of the bar, who verbally identified herself as Valerie J WINGO (5-24-71).

WINGO stated a verbal altercation broke out between two patrons but she was able to handle the situation on her own by kicking one of them out. WINGO stated **no battery or crime occurred.**

WINGO stated the business **does not** have any surveillances cameras.

While on scene, I observed the licenses **posted and they were up to date.**

During my investigation , I **did not** observe any violations in the licensed premise.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 9/9/2025 at 9:20 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

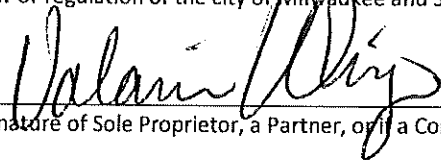
