The Milwaukee Streetcar has been experiencing service delays due to delivery vehicles blocking the path of the streetcar by stopping in the signed no parking restrictions on East Michigan Street between North Cass Street to North Lincoln Memorial Drive. Therefore, in an effort prevent this practice we recommend the current no parking restriction be replaced with a no stopping anytime tow-away zone restriction.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety and Health Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
