Resolution recognizing Peter Feigin for his accomplishments with the Milwaukee Bucks and his commitment to Milwaukee.

WHEREAS,

PETER FEIGIN

was honored for his time as president of the Milwaukee Bucks and service to the community during a special presentation in the Common Council Chambers on February 10, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Peter Feigin has served as president of the Milwaukee Bucks since 2014 and of Fiserv Forum since 2018 where his commitment to the franchise facilitated the opening of a new arena, an NBA Championship in 2021 (the first in 50 years for Milwaukee), and numerous community efforts beyond basketball; and

WHEREAS, Peter Feigin, over the course of 12 seasons, has been recognized by numerous organizations for his social and economic transformation of the Milwaukee Bucks, and striving for the betterment of the city as well as the state of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Peter Feigin, as an innovative business leader, lobbied for a public funding package in support of the construction of Fiserv Forum and renovation of the surrounding area now known as the Deer District, which has not only contributed to the growth of the Bucks' fan base, but has reshaped the sport and entertainment landscape of downtown Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, Peter Feigin's other endeavors include the development of the Milwaukee Bucks Foundation, a health organization committed to the well-being of underserved communities as well as being a board member of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Milwaukee, the Milwaukee Public Museum, the Milwaukee Public Schools Foundation and City Year Milwaukee; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith recognizes and commends Peter Feigin for his longstanding commitment to the community and many positive and impactful contributions to Milwaukee, and extends its sincere appreciation on behalf of the city, and wishes for him continued health and happiness; and, be it
