There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

**Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.**

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The caller, Harold Hafner, told police he had been playing pool in the business when he went up to the bar to order another drink. He states the bartender, Darrell Baumann, charged \$400.00 to his credit card and when Hafner demanded a refund, Baumann punched him in the face. Milwaukee Fire Department Engine #38, which was on scene treating Hafner for a minor injury to his hand, told the officer that Hafner appeared intoxicated. Hafner also told police that Baumann had taken his oxygen bottle. The officer later spoke to Hafner's caretaker, Zironna Moss, who told police that Hafner has alzheimer's and would make up stories for attention. Moss also told police that Hafner's oxygen bottle was in his home. No witness's to this incident could be located and no additional reports were written..

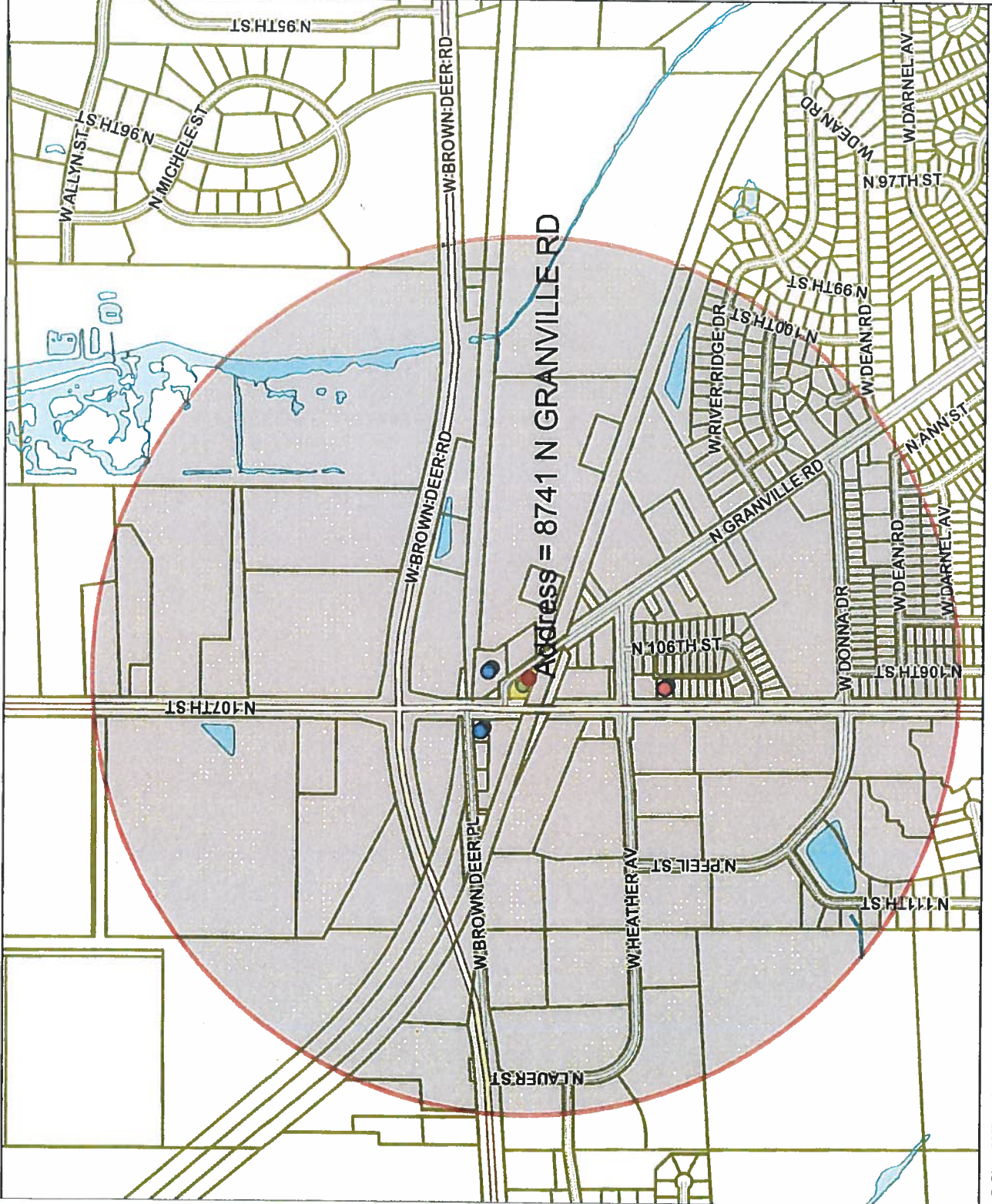

6. You may then provide testimony.



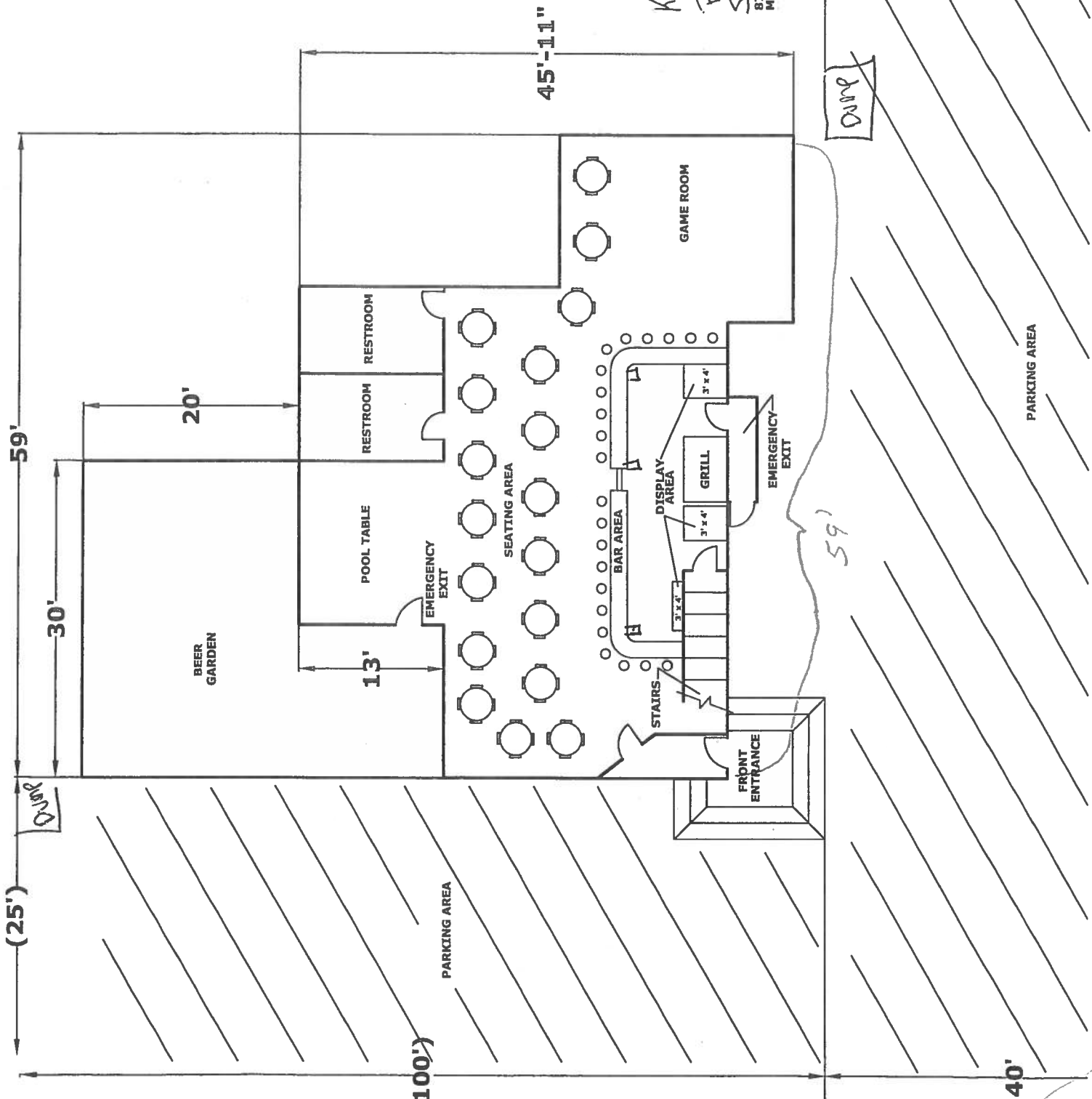

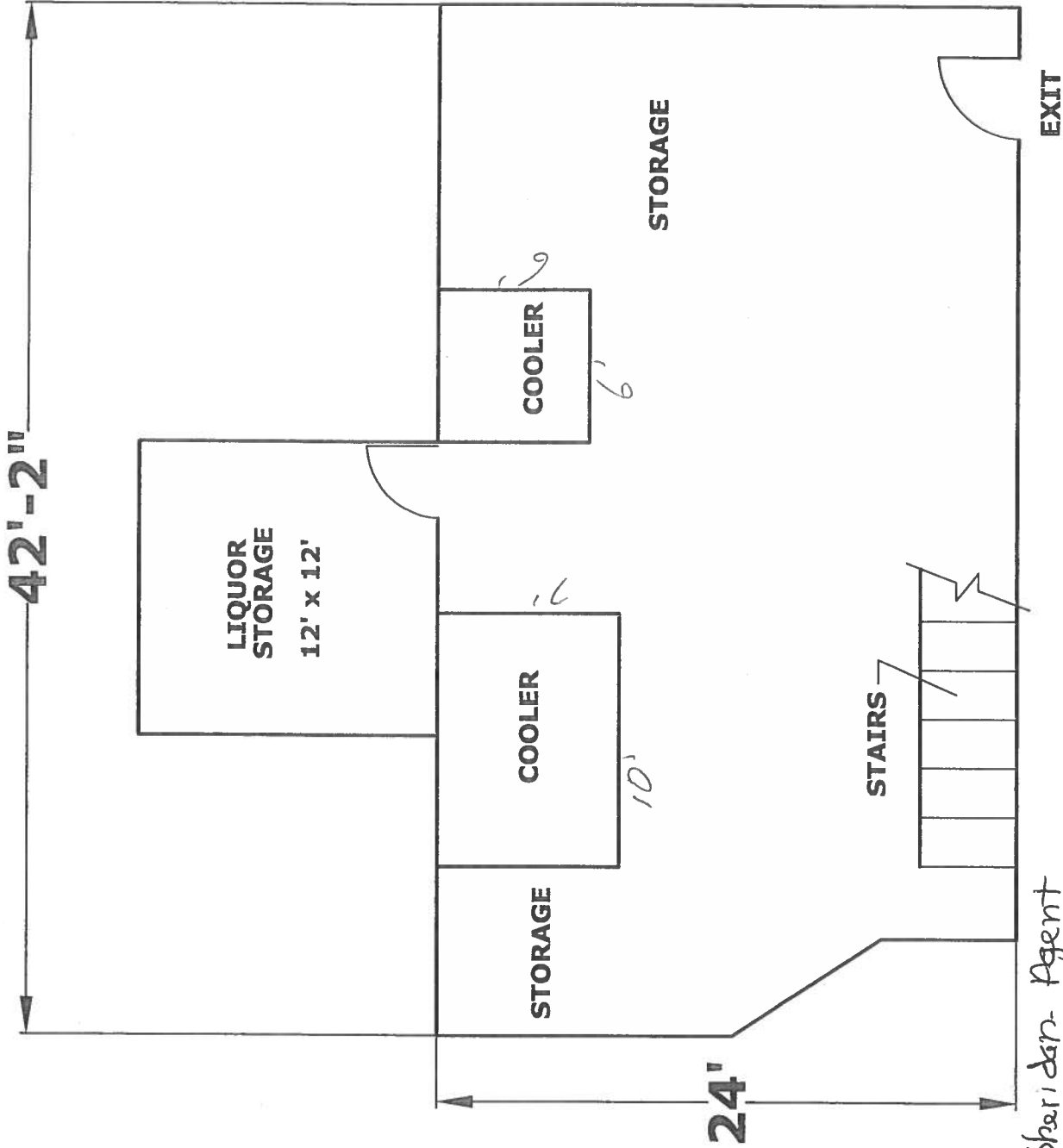

Moments after the involved subjects dispersed, several shots were heard. No additional evidence, complainants or witnesses were discovered.
8. On 12/06/2015 Milwaukee police were monitoring Kiss Ultra Lounge (7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street) when security notified them that several patrons were involved in a fight inside the business. Three subjects were cited for disorderly conduct. 8 Milwaukee police squads, in addition to the squad that had been monitoring, along with 2 Milwaukee police supervisors responded to assist in controlling the situation.
9. On 12/12/2015 Milwaukee police met with the applicant to address incidents that had occurred at Kiss Ultra Lounge recently. The applicant stated the following actions would be taken:
  - Both exits at the front of the business will be utilized.
  - The patio door will also be used as an exit for patrons.
  - Security gates will be set up in the parking lot.
  - An armed roaming security guard will be added.

Additionally, cameras have been installed at the entrance and inside the venue and two members of the security staff that had been doing a substandard job had been terminated and replaced.

10. On 01/08/2016 Milwaukee police met with the applicant regarding recent incidents at Kiss Ultra Lounge. The applicant stated that she had been hiring two off duty officers for Friday and Saturday evenings, but these officers had recently stopped coming. She asked that officers be notified and trained on how to sign up for this work detail. She further stated she had fired two security guards and she was willing to work with Milwaukee police in keeping her establishment safe.
11. On 01/10/2016 Milwaukee police were flagged down regarding a trouble with a subject complaint at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street (Kiss Ultra Lounge). Officers were told there had been a dispute inside the business and the involved parties were removed from the premises by security. These parties continued to argue in the parking lot of the business until security intervened along with Milwaukee police. The involved parties later cooperated with security and left the area. The officer reports that business staff was very cooperative and helpful.
12. On 02/07/2016 Milwaukee police were flagged down regarding a fight inside Kiss Ultra Lounge (7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street). Investigation revealed a patron of the business had been involved in a fight. Security for the business intervened and detained the subject until police arrived. This subject lied about his identity and threatened to "air the club out". This subject was arrested. During this encounter, Milwaukee police became aware there was a pending battery complaint that occurred at 76<sup>th</sup> and Mill Road. The officer responded to St. Joseph's hospital to investigate. The officer spoke to Brittany Morton who stated she had been a patron of Kiss Ultra Lounge (7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street) when she and a former friend got into a fight. One of the involved parties was struck in the head with a glass sustaining an injury to her head. Milwaukee police incident report #160380036 was filed.
13. On 02/13/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to St. Mary's hospital for a battery that occurred at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street (Kiss Ultra Lounge). The victim states she had been involved in a fight while in the main room of the bar. She sustained an abrasion to her forehead. Milwaukee police incident report #160440026 filed.
14. On 04/10/2016 Milwaukee police, who were working a special assignment at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street (Kiss Ultra Lounge), were asked by security personnel to assist with removal of a group of individuals from the business's parking lot. Officers discovered a group of approximately ten subjects in a circle fighting in the rear parking lot. These subjects scattered as officers approached which revealed a male lying on the ground bleeding from the head. This subject received medical attention from Milwaukee Fire Department Engine #39. The subject refused to speak to officers and walked away. Milwaukee police incident report #161010016 filed.




I immediately called for squad's to take control of the situation. I advised the squads to hasten up their response because several patrons were becoming increasingly unruly and disorderly.

Squad 4430 P.O. BYFIELD responded to the scene to assist with crowd control, patron dismissal, and to assist welfare of patrons who feared for their safety.

Squad 4312, Sgt DOLKIEWICZ responded to assist with supervision as well as crowd control and patron dismissal.

Squad 4360, P.O. MILLER responded to the scene to assist with crowd control, patron dismissal, and to assist welfare of patrons who feared for their safety.

The security personnel were not very helpful in this situation and were advised to step up their assistance in the future when there is an ongoing situation relative to this nature.

I then conducted an investigatory interview of Kiss Ultra Lounge security officer to ascertain pertinent information in conjunction to this investigation.

I spoke with Guard Safe Security Solutions employees Jervin A. TILLMAN (B/M, 05-15-1989) who states he is primarily assigned to parking lot and door area of Kiss Ultra Lounge. TILLMAN was assisted by 8 other security officers to help assist him in maintaining an orderly tavern.

Austin L. JOSEPH - was working inside of the tavern and noticed multiple subjects fighting on the dance floor area. Heard then called for fellow security to try and disperse the fight

Robert J. Wilson - was working inside of the tavern and noticed multiple subjects fighting on the dance floor area. Heard then called for fellow security to try and disperse the fight

Harald R. Butler was working inside of Kiss Ultra Lounge and responsibility is to monitor the inside near the dance floor and bar areas. BUTLER stated he observed a black male passed out on the floor as if he was intoxicated, BUTLER did not see any

Patrick G KEY - is responsible for the front door making sure that the parking lot is in good affect.

Travis HEARD was working inside of the tavern and noticed multiple subjects fighting on the dance floor area. Heard then called for fellow security to try and disperse the fight.

Donnell A. TAYLOR- stated he works outside by the front door and parking lot area. TAYLOR stated he head from other officer's that a fight was going on inside of the Lounge and reported inside.

Walter JENNINGS - stated he is responsible for the front door area of the Lounge.

Dale D. DEAR - DEAR stated he observed a group of 15 black male subjects V.I.P section of the dance floor. DEAR stated there was another group of subjects who were dancing in a way that affected the others around him cause confrontation. DEAR stated he was able to see that a fight was going to happen so he ran to get more help. DEAR stated moments later a fight broke out with several subject on the dance floor.

GATES also suffered an abrasion above his right eye and a small laceration under his right eye. The CAT scan also revealed questionable bleeding or a contusion burse to the anterior frontal lobe. GATE'S mother was present with him and received a call from an unknown fried of GATES that he was involved in a fight at Kiss Ultra Lounge. This License Premise report is submitted by P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN, assigned to District Four, Squad 4365, Late Shift.

On Saturday, December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2015, at 1:45 am, P.O. Martinez MOORE and I met with Jennifer GARCIA, the Licensee of Kiss Ultra Lounge, and Kiss Ultra Lounge staff. This meeting was initiated by club management to address incidents that have occurred at the establishment over the last few weeks. GARCIA and her staff put together a series of actions and exit strategies that the venue will now undertake in the event there are future incidents. Management stated that from this point forward, they will utilize both exit doors in the front vestibule, i.e. Door (A) and Door (B), respectively. In the past, the lounge has primarily used only the exit in the front of the venue. This is known as Door (A) or, the main entrance of the venue, which is for exiting patrons. In the past, Door (B) has been used essentially used as a VIP entrance.

Their second plan of action is for exiting patrons by use of their Patio Door. This exit is located directly across from the longest bar in the main room of the lounge. This exit will be utilized on busier evenings or in situations that warrant a quicker means of exiting the venue.

In addition, the security staff will also set up security gates in the parking lot area. They stated this will insure that patrons will exit the parking lot efficiently and quickly at the end of the evening. Management stated they felt these measures will help to ease or lessen the strain on the venue during the course of the evening and at closing time. They felt this would especially be the case during busy nights. GARCIA and her staff presented MOORE and I with a contingency plan for exiting the venue when there is a large crowd in attendance.

Kiss management stated they have also terminated two security personnel, whom they felt were providing substandard security duties, especially when monitoring the floor for potential problems. Kiss management stated they have hired two new security personnel. Management stated there will be two tiers of ID checkpoints at the establishment. One checkpoint will be at the entrance and the other one will be right inside the door. They stated they felt this would add an extra layer of protection against underage patrons who attempt to enter the establishment. The staff stated they plan on adding an armed roaming security guard that will monitor the parking lots on the west side of N. 76th St. And finally, Kiss Management stated new cameras have been installed inside the venue and at the entrance of the venue. Ms. Garcia and her staff stated it is their wish to set up a meeting with District Four's CLO (Community Liason Officer) and Captain Beecher. Ms. Garcia's number is 414-499-1115.

This report of an Incident Involving Licensed Person(s) or Premise(s), was written and submitted by Police Officer Jeremy CARTER, Peoplesoft #019761, assigned to District Four, on Late shift.

On Sunday, January 10, 2016, at 1:15AM, while assigned to Squad 4390, I was flagged down and responded to Trouble with Subject complaint, located in the parking lot of Kiss Ultra Lounge, which is located at 7330 N 76<sup>th</sup> St, in the city and county of Milwaukee, in the state of Wisconsin.

Upon arrival, I spoke with the parking lot entrance security guard of Kiss Ultra Lounge, who informed me that a group of approximately ten to twenty patrons were inside Kiss Ultra Lounge and engaged in a verbal dispute with other patrons inside Kiss. It was stated that the group was very disorderly and got in other people's face, so they were asked to leave the bar. Security had to then remove the subjects due to the disorderly patrons not being willing to leave. The patrons continued to engage in a verbal dispute as the security removed them from inside of Kiss Ultra Lounge.

I then observed approximately fifteen feet, northbound from the front entrance, a group of approximately ten to twenty subjects yelling and engaging in disorderly conduct. I requested for more squad cars to my location for crowd control.

Security was observed intervening in the verbal dispute and separated the disorderly females who continued to engage in a verbal dispute with security, who told them they had to leave. I observed two patrons who were very disorderly, engaging in a verbal dispute, attempting to move passed the security guards and refused to leave the parking lot, immediately.

Patron (actor) #1, was described as a black female, unknown name, approximately mid 20's, light skinned, approximately 5ft 3in, 110lbs, slender build, with long black hair and tattoos on her arm or upper torso, wearing a dress, possibly colored black, had been the main.

Patron (actor) #2, was described as a black female, unknown name, approximately mid 20's to early 30's, medium brown skinned, approximately 5ft 7in, 120-140lbs, slender build, with long dark hair, wearing a dark colored dress, with a see-through, no strapped dress.

While dressed in my full Milwaukee Police uniform, and wearing an outer vest carrier with a Milwaukee Police badge, I informed myself as "Milwaukee Police" and informed the patrons to leave the parking lot. I informed the group of patrons that they needed to leave immediately.

Security stayed in the parking lot, separating the group of patrons to prevent them from escalating into a physical altercation, and instructed them to also get in their vehicles and leave the premise. The two disorderly patrons later calmed down and cooperated with security, leaving the parking lot.

Let it be noted that Squad 4365 (PO Martinez MOORE and Ralph MCCLAIN), Squad 4340 (PO Jonathan MILLER), and Squad 4311 (SGT Todd LEWAN) arrived on scene, while the subjects were still being disorderly and aided in controlling the crowd, assisting with the patrons leaving the premise, and getting information from security.

The security or any other patrons wanted to prosecute on the disorderly patrons. There was no physical altercation that occurred only a verbal dispute which disruptive and disorderly to the establishment of the Kiss Ultra Lounge.

Kiss Ultra Lounge manager, identified as Ralph E JOHNSON(m/b, 02-21-65) was notified of the incident. Let it be noted that the staff of Kiss Ultra Lounge was very cooperative and helpful in assisting Milwaukee Police personnel in dispersing of the crowd, as well as, in the investigation.

On Sunday, 02-07-16 at approximately 1:45 am, P.O. Lafayette EMMONS and I were flagged down while work a special event DPM at KISS Ultra Lounge located at 7330 North 76th Street, which is in the city and county of Milwaukee, We were informed by KISS Ultra Lounge manager Craig L. BERRY (b/m, 11-017-67) that a fight erupted inside the lounge area. BERRY stated a medium complexion unknown black male approximately 6 ft, 160 lbs; short braids and dressed in multi-colored blue shirt was involved in the fight. BERRY stated his security team stepped into the situation to resolve the altercation and detained the unknown black male for MPD.

We took the unknown black male into custody and placed him in the back of our marked MPD vehicle. I asked the unknown black male for his identification and he provide me with his Wisconsin drivers license (M254-8728-4174-01) displaying the name Virgil L. MCNEIL Jr. (b/m, 05-14-84, 1850 North 25th Street). I looked at the Wisconsin drivers license closely and noticed that the photo on the license was a little different. EMMONS and I asked the unknown black male for his real name and he knowingly continued to give us false information with intent to mislead us in the performance of our duty. Based on our observation of the unknown black male, his demeanor was combative and he had a strong odor of alcohol on his breath.

I interviewed KISS Ultra Lounge security officer Edward W. HAMILTON (b/m, 03-11-85) who stated the above-unknown black male was fight inside the club. HAMILTON and his team members removed the unknown black male from inside the lounge. HAMILTON stated while escorting the unknown black male out the lounge he made a threat: He's going to get his thumper and air the club out.

I interviewed KISS Ultra Lounge security officer Brandon I. KING (b/m, 08-06-84) who stated the above-unknown black male was fight inside the club. KING stated he and other security members approached the unknown black male inside the club waving his arms and screaming, "I'm from 39th and Brown hood." KING stated the unknown black male was apprehended and escorted out of the club. During the process of escorting the unknown black male out the club he made a threat to come back and air out the club.

A wanted check was conducted on MCNEIL, which revealed no wants. We conducted a name search with photo of Virgil MCNEIL in our Tiburon system, which resulted the unknown black male we had in custody was not him. The unknown black male was conveyed to District 4 for identification and processing purposes.

While at District 4 we utilized the pre-booking, one finger print system, and it identified the subject as Korbel I. GRAY (b/m, 09-21-88). A wanted check was conducted on GRAY, which revealed he was on probation with Department of Community Correction (DOCC) for Operating vehicle without owners consent and had he outstanding municipal warrants with MPD.

On 02-07-16 at approximately 3:15AM I checked the CAD and seen there was a call pending for a battery cutting that occurred at a nightclub on 76th and Mill Road. There isn't a nightclub at 76th and Mill Road and Kiss Ultra Lounge is near that location. I responded to St Joseph's hospital (5000 W. Chambers Street) to investigate this battery cutting.

Upon arrival I spoke to Brittany A. MORTON (W/F, 11-01-82) in room #13. MORTON stated she was a friend of France WILLIAMS but she was trying to better herself so she dissolved the friendship. MORTON stated she seen WILLIAMS tonight at Kiss Ultra Lounge (7330 N. 76th Street). MORTON stated WILLIAMS ran up on her in an aggressive manner, three times. MORTON stated the last time WILLIAMS ran up on her, they got into an argument and she hit WILLIAMS in her head with a glass and they started to fight.

I spoke to France S. WILLIAMS (B/F, 09-29-82) in room #21. WILLIAMS stated she was a friend of Brittany MORTON, DOB of 11-01-82 for several years and she doesn't know why they are no longer friends. WILLIAMS stated she and MORTON exchanged words inside the club and about an hour later when she was getting ready to leave MORTON hit her in her head with a bottle or a glass, causing a 3/4 inch laceration on the right side of her head and two long scratches on her forehead. WILLIAMS was treated at St Joseph's Hospital and her laceration was closed with Dermabond adhesive and a steri-strip.

MORTON was arrested and conveyed to District #4 for processing. After processing MORTON was conveyed to District #3 where a Miranda Interview was conducted. During the Miranda Interview MORTON confessed to hitting WILLIAMS in her head with a glass.
