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I am submitting my brief comments re: agenda items #4 & 5, which were originally scheduled for public discussion, but reposted as closed.

Thursday I attended a meeting with other community members who were planning to attend these hearings. We all are concerned there is critical need for an environmental impact assessment of the Midtown property due to both the heat and the horrible flooding in the area that have already been created by the excessive pavement and big box development built on top of the underground springs. We all agreed that our community needs this property to be developed very differently than was recently proposed by Mr. Overhue and Ald. Chambers and perhaps other officials. We agreed that the Midtown property NOT be rezoned to a higher industrial use and that another storage facility is NOT needed in our community. Our community needs thoughtful, environmentally conscious strategies that will support living wages and neighborhood vitality.

I hope you'll take the time to read and consider my comments. As a long-time Milwaukee resident, I remain available to work with others in making these decisions and finding solutions.

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
