Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers Karlton Boswell, Gregory Heaney and John Pruitt. The claim is in the amount of \$1,288.87, including \$12.87 in disbursements for 11.60 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Tarance WILLIAMS and they left the hotel feeling that Mr. Albert WILLIAMS was in a secure environment. Officers further state they had no knowledge of any other information that would lead them to believe that Mr. WILLIAMS was in need of medical attention.

On August 10, 2000, Assistant District Attorney Thomas MCADAMS reviewed this complaint and declined to issue any charges against any of the officers.

CONCLUSION:

Investigation by the Criminal Investigation Unit revealed that Albert WILLIAMS checked into the Ambassador Hotel on April 9, 2000 in an intoxicated state, and his subsequent death was due to an insulin overdose compounded by the alcohol that he ingested. The death was in fact ruled a suicide by the Medical Examiner's office. The police officers, PRUITT, BOSWELL and HEANEY, who were sent to the hotel for the "trouble with a customer" had no knowledge that Mr. Albert WILLIAMS situation was life threatening and were only told that he was drunk. Assistant District Attorney Thomas MCADAMS reviewed the case and found no wrongdoing on the part of any of the officers involved in this investigation, therefore this complaint will be cleared as warrant refused.
