Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

I work at St. Joseph's Hospital and typically park on the 3200 block of north 47th Street – just south of Chambers Street. On Monday, August 20th at about 08:00am I arrived in the same area and drove east on Chambers to 47th Street and turned right (south) to park (I usually park right off the corner). At that time I did notice that 47th street was closed to the north, however, I did NOT notice any barriers or signs indicating that there was any construction on the block south of Chambers on 47th street where I had just parked – this fact tipped me off to actually look for any restrictions and I saw none – I parked right next to the one-way sign at the north end of 47th Street. 
