**Re: Class B Tavern License, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer License Applications and Business Operations for "Indian Bistro LLC" at 8665 W BROWN DEER Rd.**

Dear Mr. Chanana,

On Wednesday, August 2, 2023 the Granville Advisory Committee met to review your business operations and pursuance of Class B Tavern License, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer Licenses for “Indian Bistro” at 8665 W. Brown Deer. Rd. Based on the information provided, the Granville Advisory Committee recommended to support, by a vote of 3 ayes, 2 noes, and 2 excused, your business operations and pursuance of the aforementioned licenses. The committee made this advisory recommendation based upon testimony from the property owner that business operations would primarily operate as a restaurant with a bar serving lunch and dinner from 11 am to 11 pm, possibly expand to offer breakfast service in the future, offer primarily Indian foods, supplement food service with alcoholic beverages, hold events and operate beyond 11 pm on an as-needed basis, that events and operations beyond 11 pm would end an hour earlier than 2 am closing time as a practice, and that the business would support but operate separately from the adjacent gas station at 8659-61 W. Brown Deer Rd. despite both businesses being family-owned.

The Granville Advisory Committee requests that this advisory recommendation be considered and supported by the Common Council, the Board of Zoning Appeals, the City Planning Commission, appropriate City officials, or other relevant City decision-making bodies on development proposals within the Granville Development District.

The Granville Development Advisory Committee was established to review plans and proposals for redevelopment projects in the Granville Development District for consistency with the goals, needs, and desires of the Granville community and its residents, businesses, property owners and other stakeholders.

The Granville Development District consists of the city of Milwaukee portion of the area bounded by W. County Line Road, W. Good Hope Road, N. 60<sup>th</sup> Street and N. 107th Street.
