Alderman Stamper,

I am writing to you this morning for two reasons.

The second item has me a bit frustrated this morning. I'm not sure if you know, but I pick up trash every morning -- especially during this time of year when the snow is melting. I got up an hour earlier than usual and spent a long time cleaning up all along 48th, between Lisbon and Meinecke. The area surrounding Judy's Red Hots. Piles of trash. Namely beer bottles from people congregating at the property after bar close. When the owner actually showed up, I was in the process of throwing away a large bag of trash. I politely asked him why things were so neglected -- "Didn't you guys used to have a person picking up garbage?" -- but he became immediately defensive and yelling that he picks up trash every day. (Definitely not true.)

It got me thinking that we can do better on this corner. As you know, there are business owners who are willing to positively engage with the community. Judy's is not one of those. It's not just the constant trash. It's also the fact that he cater's primarily to the 2 a.m. crowd. That's his business strategy, and it's not a positive one for the community. Every time me and my neighbors complain, he offers us free hotdogs. Honestly, we don't need free hotdogs. We need a commercial anchor that is invested in uplifting the neighborhood (while making a profit, of course) at this key location in Uptown Crossing. As you know, there has been significant violence and health code violations at this business, as well.

I write to formally ask that this food license be revoked, or at the very least that the item be thoroughly discussed by you and your colleagues, as well as residents, via the License Committee. I am cc-ing Mr. City Clerk, so that he also has a record of my complaint.

Thank you for your time, consideration and leadership. I look forward to talking more about this with you if you have time.

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/18/2013 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 2000 West Mitchell Street (Club 039). During this check, officers observed that the bartender on duty, Brenda L. Melendez, did not have her Class D Operators license with her. The bartender was advised that she needed to have her license with her when she works and no other violations were observed.
2. On 02/07/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 2000 West Mitchell Street (Club 039). During this check, officers observed fruit flies in one of the bottles of liquor. The applicant was instructed to dispose of the contents of that bottle and no other violations were observed.

3. On 07/06/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 2000 West Mitchell Street (Club 39) based on a complaint of loud music and after hours operation. Officers spoke to a bartender, Lilliam Torres, who stated they sometimes close early when the bar is not very busy and they keep the doors closed to avoid loud music complaints. Torres also told officers the bar has cameras and the police can check them any time they wish to investigate complaints against the business.

4. On 12/24/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a Battery-Cutting complaint at 2004 West Mitchell Street. Officers discovered the victim, Rafael Hernandez-Santiago, had received a cut to his abdomen. The victim identified himself as co-owner of Club 039 and stated he had been cut by a patron of the business as he attempted to break up a fight. Milwaukee police incident report #143580147 filed.

This report is written by P.O. Luis VARGAS-RAMOS, assigned to District Two, Early Shift.

On Wednesday, December 24, 2014, at approximately 10:26pm, while assigned to Squad 2290, P.O. Mark LINDSTRUM and I were dispatched to 2004 W. Mitchell St, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, for a battery cutting complaint.

Upon arrival, I observed approximately four subjects surrounding the suspect that was laying on the ground. The suspect was later identified as Benny CARRASQUILLO (W/M, 01-05-71). CARRASQUILLO was on the ground bleeding from the mouth and complaining of pain. I then located the victim who identified himself as Rafael HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO (W/M, 03-24-68). HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated CARRASQUILLO cut him with a carpet cutter around his left abdomen, causing pain and injury. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO was conveyed by MFD Med 3 to Froedert Hospital to treat his injury. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO resides at 6426 W. Eden Pl. and his phone number is 414-418-3823.

HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated he and his wife, who he identified as Lori HERNANDEZ (W/F, 03-24-68, Tavern B license), are the owners of the Club 039. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO was very corrapertive with us. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated CARRASQUILLO entered the bar and he noticed CARRASQUILLO was intoxicated. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated CARRASQUILLO walked around the bar and began to harrass some of the people inside. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated CARRASQUILLO then pulled an older man's arm, causing the old man to fall to the ground. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated he then went around the bar counter and started to push CARRASQUILLO out the bar. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated at the same time he was pushing CARRASQUILLO out he was telling him to leave. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated CARRASQUILLO then asked him to come outside so he could talk to him and HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated he went outside. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated as they were talking outside two unknown subjects exited the bar and began to fight with CARRASQUILLO. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO stated he ran towards them trying to seperate them from fighting and thats when CARRASQUILLO swings his arm and cuts him with the carpet cutter around his abdomen, causing a deep larceration. HERNANDEZ-SANTIAGO received a laceration that required a total of four stitches.

It should be noted that the owner and employees at Club 039 were cooraperative. For a detailed report please refer to IR# 14-3580147. It should also be noted that this establishment is known to not cooperate with Police investigations. Licenses were properly posted.

This report is written by P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ, assigned to District 2, Early Shift, Community Prosecution Unit.

On June 09, 2014, the District 2, Community Prosecution Unit, received a complaint for loud music and after hour's operation for Club 39 from the Southside Organizing Committee.

On July 06, 2014, at approximately 3:00 p.m., Squad 2268 (P.O. VODICKA/ P.O. VELASQUEZ) conducted a License Premise Investigation. Upon arrival, I spoke to Lilliam TORRES who stated she is usually one of the closing bartenders. She stated business has been slow and that sometimes they close early. She stated they usually keep the door closed to avoid loud music complaints but that she will check the exterior of the bar to make sure that the noise level is not too loud. TORRES stated the bar has cameras and that the Milwaukee Police Department can check them whenever we want to investigate the complaints against the bar.
