This letter is to inform you that the above matter will be considered at the March 4th Historic Preservation Commission meeting, which begins at 3:00 p.m. in Room 301-B of Milwaukee City Hall, 200 E Wells St.

At this meeting, you or a representative may speak on this application for historic designation. I have enclosed a copy of the application submitted by the nominator. The Commission will grant temporary designation if it finds there is substantial likelihood that the Commission will recommend permanent historic designation. Temporary designation shall be effective until the Commission either recommends or denies permanent designation and the period for appeals of that decision has expired, but in no event more than 180 days from the day of the Commission's decision granting temporary designation.
