Dear Chairperson:

Currently, there are two separate rates for ten-hour meters in the City of Milwaukee Central Business District (CBD), twenty cents an hour and twenty-five cents an hour. To maintain consistency within the CBD we recommend the following areas be changed to twenty-five cents per hour:

Both sides of North Broadway from East Juneau Avenue to East Knapp Street
Both sides of North Market Street from East Juneau Avenue to East Knapp Street
Both sides of East Knapp Street from North Broadway to North Market Street
Both sides of East Knapp Street from North Market Street to North Water Street
Both sides of North Water Street from East Knapp Street to East Cherry Street
Both sides of North Edison Street from East Knapp Street to East Cherry Street

East side of North Broadway from East Clybourn Street to East St. Paul Avenue
South side of East Buffalo Street from North Jackson Street to North Van Buren Street
North side of East Chicago Street from North Jackson Street to North Jefferson Street
Both sides of East Menomonee Street from North Jefferson Street to North Milwaukee Street
West side of North Van Buren Street from East St. Paul Avenue to East Buffalo Street
Both sides of North Jackson Street from East Buffalo Street to East Chicago Street
West side of North Jackson Street from East St. Paul Avenue to East Buffalo Street
Both sides of North Jefferson Street from East Menomonee Street to East Corcoran Avenue



In conjunction with the reconstruction of South Howell Avenue and new lane pattern, the above-captioned parking restriction is needed.
