REASON FOR REQUEST:

The claimant, Mario Jackson, was a passenger in a City of Milwaukee Police Squad car that was stopped on South Muskego Avenue at the red traffic signal facing northbound at the intersection with West Mitchell street. The uninsured motorist, who was fleeing police and traveling southbound on South Muskego Avenue at a high rate of speed, failed to stop at the red traffic signal, colliding with another vehicle that was traveling eastbound on West Mitchell Street and subsequently colliding with the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

The claimant sustained injuries to his head, neck, back and left shoulder. The claimed medical expenses total \$18,932.99, which includes \$6,385.00 of unpaid bills that are the claimant's responsibility.
