

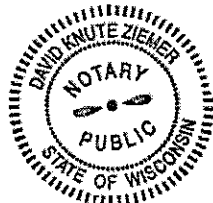

Substitute resolution approving levying of assessments and construction of assessable public improvement projects at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City cast of these projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$128,000 for a total estimated cost of \$135,200.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions, determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct and levy special assessments for the following improvements:

**5th Aldermanic District  
Alley between W. Appleton Ave., W. Congress St., W. Ruby Ave., and N. 80th St. (ST212 120102) File Number 110161:** Concrete alley pavement reconstruction, replace some abutting walk or driveway approaches, grading, and storm drainage facilities where necessary. (Assessable Alley Paving Fund - \$32,800; Nonassessable Alley Paving Fund - \$85,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$125,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2012 construction season and funded with the 2012 budgeted funds.

**6th Aldermanic District  
N. Hubbard St. - E. Meinecke Ave. to E. Wright St. (ST211 110158):** Install traffic calming

speed hump(s). (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$7,200; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$3,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$10,200. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2012 construction season.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Commissioner of Public Works' Report, as amended at said Public Hearing, is approved and the properties therein identified are benefited; and, be it

Further Resolved, That said Commissioner of Public Works is authorized and directed to proceed with said work in accordance with said report pursuant to Section 66.0703 and any other pertinent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes and in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting or adjacent properties and collect such assessment in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the projects do not involve any parcels of agricultural land which are eligible for deferred special assessments under the provisions of Section 14.30 of the

Milwaukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as specified in the above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects: Alley W. Appleton Ave. (ST212120102) and N. Hubbard St. (ST211110158) will be billed after January 1, 2014; but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed.
