

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 03/20/11 at 2:05 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 76th & Bluemound for a large fight complaint, which involved patrons from the Brewski's Sports Club. The call was originated from Wauwatosa Police Department and they provided an update to MPD that one subject may have a gun. Investigation found some patrons started to argue with others in the game room with security separating the subjects and escorted the first group of patrons out of the bar. The second group of patrons later left however the subjects from the first group were waiting in a car and when they observed the other subjects leaving the bar, began to fight them. As police arrived, the subjects fled. Police did speak with the bartender, Marty Schwader, and got his statement. Schwader stated to police that he would have security monitor the game area more closely so this type of incident doesn't happen again.
- 2. On 06/20/11 at 1:36 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 322 N 76th Street for a Trouble with Subject complaint. Police spoke with the caller who stated at 1:20 am, he was awakened by patrons "yelling, hooping and hollering, and banging on tables in the patio area at Brewski's Bar. The caller stated he expects noise on the weekends from the bar, but not on a Sunday night when people have to work in the morning. Officers checked Brewski's Sports Club and spoke with the bartender Austin Algaier who stated the patrons were playing "Bags" (a beanbag toss game) but that the game ended at 1:10 am and the staff had closed up the patio. Algaier stated he did not believe the people were overly loud but the bags may have been loud. Algaier stated in the future, he would close the patio earlier. A warning was issued.

3. On 01/15/12 at 3:05 am, Milwaukee police investigated an "After Hours" complaint at 304 N 76th Street. As officers arrived at the bar, they observed a number of autos in the parking lots on both north and south sides of the building. As officers approached the bar, they could hear loud music and voices coming from inside. Police had to knock three times in order before they were allowed entry even though some patrons saw police out front. Once inside, police observed patrons sitting at the bar and subjects stocking merchandise behind the bar. Investigation found some patrons were in the bar after hours. Police spoke with the manager Brian Young regarding violations of non-employees in the bar after hours. Officers spoke with Kevin Nugent via phone who was advised of the incident. Nugent was also cited for the violation.

4. Milwaukee police detectives were dispatched to Froedtert Hospital regarding an incident that occurred at Brewskis Sports Club (304 North 76th Street) on 12/29/2013. Investigation revealed a fight occurred inside the business between three patrons, resulting in two patrons sustaining bite wounds. Employees of the business intervened, separating the combatants and calling police. Milwaukee police incident report #133630102 filed.

- 5. On 05/02/2017officers were dispatched to a fight at Brewski's Sports Club, 304 N. 76th St. The investigation revealed a fight had started inside but primarily occurred outside. The bar's security was able to get the parties outside, separate them and send them on their separate ways. None of the parties involved wanted to press charges.
- 6. On 08/21/2017 officers were dispatched to entry to autos at Brewski's Bar, 304 N. 76th St. The victim had parked her car in the parking lot at 10:30pm. When she came out she found her window broken and property missing. The bar has security cameras but they did not cover the area where the car was parked.

7. On 03/03/2018 at 5:12pm officers were dispatched to a battery at Brewski's Sport Club, 304 N. 76th St. The officer interviewed Richard KOVAL, the manager at Brewski's. He stated that on 03/03/2018 at about 2:30am there was a fight outside the bar. He went outside with a bartender, Nicholas TURENNE, to break up the fight. While outside a male subject hit TURENNE to the face causing a cut lip that required stitches to close. The same male hit

KOVAL to the face causing minor injuries. KOVAL stated he would check the video surveillance to see if the subject had been in the bar.

- 8. On 03/25/2018 at 1:21am officers were dispatched to a Sick and Injured at 304 N. 76th St. The officer spoke with the bartender, Brenda BARRALES, who stated a customer had about 3 drinks and went to the bathroom. When the customer returned he passed out, urinated on the floor and puked on the floor. BARRALES helped the customer outside to wait for MFD, who transported the subject to the hospital.
- 9. On 06/03/2018 at 1:22am officers were dispatched to a subject with weapon at 304 N. 76th St. The witnesses stated a subject had started an altercation and armed himself with a knife. The subject left the bar and no injuries were reported.
- 10. On 08/19/2018 officers were dispatched to Brewski's Sports Club, 304 N. 76th St, for a property damage complaint. The officer interviewed the bouncer, Shakir MUHAMMAD, who stated he broke up a fight and had to escort a subject outside. Once outside the subject punched the glass window breaking it. He subject was arrested for damage to property.

This report is written by P.O. Michael WEILAND assigned to District 3, Modified Early Shift.

On Monday, March 05, 2018 at 5:12PM P.O. Librado BRACERO and I were dispatched to 304 N 76th St (Brewski's Sports Club) to investigate a battery. Upon our arrival I interviewed one of the victims, Richard G KOVAL (W/M 06-10-78), who is a manager at Brewski's. KOVAL stated that around 2:20AM-2:30AM on Saturday, March 03, 2018 he was informed that there was a fight outside of the establishment. KOVAL stated that he went outside to try and stop people from fighting. KOVAL stated that he observed a B/F and a W/F engaged in a physical altercation. KOVAL stated that he started telling people to go home and that they didn't want any problems. KOVAL stated that one of the bartenders, Nicholas R TURENNE (W/M 06-24-93), came outside too. KOVAL stated that there was a W/M and a B/M attempting to separate the two females. KOVAL stated that while he and TURENNE were trying to tell people to leave the W/M became upset and started to push TURENNE. KOVAL stated that the W/M then punched TURENNE in the face twice with a closed fist causing injury to TURENNE. KOVAL stated that he was helping TURENNE walk back into the bar when the W/M came up beside him and punched him in the face with a closed fist causing pain and injury. TURENNE suffered a laceration to his upper lip that required stitches. KOVAL had a nose bleed, and minor lacerations to the inside of his upper and lower lip that did not need medical attention.

On Tuesday, March 06, 2018 I conducted follow-up regarding this case and interviewed TURENNE at his home. TURENNE stated that the incident happened at approximately 3:00AM outside in front of the establishment. TURENNE stated that he heard KOVAL call for help and he went outside. TURENNE stated that he went outside and heard yelling and started telling people to go home. TURENNE stated that a W/M became upset, took his shirt off and said, "This is what I do." TURENNE stated that the subject then struck him in the face twice causing pain and injury. TURENNE stated that he stumbled backwards and KOVAL told him to go inside. TURENNE stated that once inside there was no further altercation.

Both KOVAL and TURENNE stated that the subject may have been inside the bar, KOVAL stated that he would look through video to see if there is any video of the subject in the bar.

This report is submitted by Police Officer Adam GONZALEZ, assigned to District Three, late shift. On Sunday, August 19, 2018, my partner (Police Officer Antonio OBREGON) and I were dispatched to 304 N. 76th St. (Brewski's Sports Club), which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, in the State of Wisconsin for a property damage complaint.

Upon arrival, I spoke to the General Manager of Brewski's Sports Club who identified himself as Richard G. KOVAL (w/m 6-10-1978). KOVAL stated he received a telephone call from his employees about an incident that occurred at the bar. He was told that two patrons of the bar were fighting and when the bouncers broke up the fight, one of the patrons started to damage two double panes 36 inch by 18 inch glass windows. KOVAL estimated the damage to be \$1,500.00. KOVAL stated he did not witness the incident but would still like to prosecute.

I spoke to Shakir A. MUHAMMAD (b/m 8-8-1981) who stated he is employed at Brewski's Sports Club as a bouncer. MUHAMMAD stated he was outside the bar checking ID's when he heard commotion coming from inside the bar. When he walked inside he observed an unknown male strike the suspect who was later identified as Joseph D. KOUTNIK (w/m 9-22-1981) in the face. At that time a bar fight ensued between KOUTNIK and the unknown male, which was immediately broken up by MUHAMMAD. MUHAMMAD stated things started to calm down however KOUTNIK was still being aggressive, which caused MUHAMMAD to keep restraining him. While restraining KOUTNIK, MUHAMMAD stated he fell onto his back with KOUTNIK on top. At that time KOUTNIK bit MUHAMMAD in the right upper chest. MUHAMMAD stated he did not want to be a victim of a battery. MUHAMMAD stated he was able to get up and grab KOUTNIK and carry him out of the bar. KOUTNIK stood on the




