REASON FOR REQUEST:

David Letteer, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and standing next to his squad car in the parking lane of northbound traffic near 2534 North Hopkins Street. There were other City of Milwaukee police vehicles in the area, including a marked police vehicle with emergency lights activated. The uninsured motorist, who was intoxicated and traveling north on North Hopkins Street, struck several parked vehicles and Officer Letteer, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

As a result of the impact, Officer Letteer sustained injuries to his neck, right foot, right knee, and left wrist. The treating physician indicated the right foot, right knee, and left wrist injuries are permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$54,872.71.
