
This is to notify you that on Tuesday, November 11, 2025, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to renew your Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses with a 20 (twenty) day suspension based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operation; for the premises located at 1044 N MARTIN L KING JR DR.. ("RED WHITE AND BLUE").

On November 14, 2025, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses in which the Committee recommended renewal with a 20 (twenty) day suspension of the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting on Tuesday, November 25, 2025 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee and you did appear in person.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted renewal with a 10 (ten) day suspension of the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operation.

Said suspension is in effect between 12:00 a.m. on November 26, 2025 until 11:59 p.m. on December 5, 2025.


