Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. 3. On 12/29/14 at 11:12 pm, Milwaukee police responded to 2624 W Lisbon Avenue for a ShotSpotter that occurred at 1843 N 30th Street. Investigation revealed a vehicle left N 30th Street at a high rate of speed and entered the parking lot of 2624 W Lisbon. The driver exited the auto and walked into the store, despite officers ordering the driver to stay in the car. The subject then entered the gas station and officers observed the subject walk to one area of the store and shortly thereafter, exited and attempted to re-enter his car, when officers arrested him. An officer entered the store and could smell a strong odor of marijuana and based on his observations of where he last saw the subject at, walked over to that area and observed two clear plastic sandwich bags containing an off white chunky substance, suspected of cocaine, placed inside of a Munch peanut butter box. Police also viewed video surveillance of the incident. The substance tested positive for cocaine. The suspect was found to be in possession of \$4,263.50, that is consistent with that of street level sales.

6. On 12/29/2015 at 12:26am officers were dispatched to 2624 W. Lisbon Ave for a ShotSpotter call. A call was also received from the business for shots fired. The applicant stated to officers a fight started by the door and he heard several shots outside. The applicant provided the officers with video of the incident. The video showed occupants of two different autos getting into an argument by the front door. One of the subjects runs back to his car and appears to be pointing something at the other auto. Nine casings were recovered in the area that subject was standing. All subjects fled prior to police arrival. Milwaukee Police Department report # 15-363-0008 was filed.

1. On 03/27/16 at 3:21 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2624 W Lisbon Avenue. Investigation revealed a subject inside the station had a gunshot wound to the right shoulder. The victim has entered the station to make a purchase and when exiting, the suspect came from behind the gas pumps and pointed a gun at the victim and fired from close range, striking the victim. Both subjects began to fight with the suspect fleeing from the area. The incident was caught on video surveillance. Officers were unable to make contact with the owner of the premise.
2. On 01/05/17 at 9:03 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 27th and Lisbon for a battery complaint. Upon arrival, police located the victim on the sidewalk in the 1800 block of N 27th Street. The victim suffered traumatic injuries to his head and despite lifesaving measures by MFD, the victim was pronounced deceased at the scene. Investigation revealed the victim was an employee at the Lisbon BP located at 2624 W Lisbon. Video surveillance captured the victim confronting the suspect as soon as the suspect entered the premise. It appeared that the victim ordered the suspect to leave the store. The suspect then grabbed several items from the premise and headed for the door. The victim and suspect engaged in a brief struggle, and the suspect broke free and ran west across N 27th Street. The victim, who was carrying a baseball bat, chased after the suspect. The two went out of camera range but came back into view and in the distance, the suspect could be seen striking the victim while he is on the ground. A witness observed the incident and provided a statement to police.

The clerk stated the subject was asked to leave several times. The subject refused to leave when the officer advised him to and he was arrested.
6. On 01/14/2018 at 2:08am officers were dispatched to a ShotSpotter call at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The investigation revealed a customer at the gas station bumped into another customer inside the store. As the customer was leaving the store several shots were fired at him from across the street. The nephew of the victim, who is a CCW permit holder, returned fire at the suspect. The suspect vehicle fled the scene. MPD report filed.

7. On 01/17/2018 1:56pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject call at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The caller stated a known panhandle had been outside but had left just prior to the officer's arrival. The officers were not able to locate the subject.

Officers interviewed the victim who stated that an employee of the filling station "head butted" her and hit her multiple times with a baseball bat. The employee admitted to "head butting" her after she spit in his face and hit her with a bat after she threw around items inside the store. Surveillance video confirmed the altercation inside the establishment. Both parties were ordered into the District Attorney's office.
23. On 03/16/19 at 8:39am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue for a disorderly conduct complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject entered the store and began smoking. When the clerk asked him to put the cigarette out, the subject blew smoke in the employees face. The subject entered a second time and caused a disturbance. The subject was located and arrested.
24. On 03/17/19 at 10:48am, Milwaukee Police observed a subject loitering in front of 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue. The subject was arrested.

Investigation revealed that a subject entered the establishment and caused 400 dollars' worth of damage by kicking the front door and throwing a fire extinguisher. Surveillance video from the filling station revealed a group of subject punching and kicking a male subject in the parking lot of the location. The subject who was being battered went to his vehicle, produced a handgun and fired at the group fleeing the parking lot of the filling station. At no time during the incident did the employees call 911 or the non-emergency number to report the incident.
36. On 09/14/19 a 17 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative, was able to purchase a 2 pack of Mango Swisher Sweet Cigars at 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue, The sales clerk admitted to selling the item and the applicant was issued a citation.

Investigation revealed that a subject entered the store, took \$90.00 worth of food items and left the establishment through a door held open by another individual. The business provided video of the incident. The subjects fled in a vehicle and a report was filed.
39. On 09/23/19 at 4:08am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue for a threat complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject entered the store and tried to purchase a carton of cigarettes. When the employee asked for his driver's license, the subject stated he did not have it, so the employee refused to sell him the carton. The subject grabbed around 15-20 dollars' worth of merchandise and walked out of the station.
40. On 09/28/19 at 3:37pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue for a trouble with subject complaint. Upon arrival, officers interviewed the caller/employee who stated that there was a panhandler outside the location. The employee was very cooperative and showed officers video surveillance of the subject. The subject is known to police but could not be located.
41. On 10/23/19 at 12:31pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue for a theft complaint. Upon arrival, officers interviewed the caller/employee who stated that two subjects have entered the station, on multiple occasions, and stolen items. One subject would distract him while the other subject would steal items. The incidents were captured on video surveillance and the actors leave in a vehicle.

Items #36 and 37 updated with new court dates on 11/12/2020

42. On 01/09/2020 officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The clerk stated there had been a subject on the lot panhandling. The subject was gone when the officers arrived. The officers were unable to locate the subject.
43. On 03/30/2020 at 9:31am officers were dispatched to a subject panhandling at the BP gas station, 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The clerk pointed out the subjects to the officers. The subject was identified and advised to leave the station and not return.
44. On 09/02/2020 at 10:15pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 2324 W. Lisbon Av. The clerk stated there was a female at the store that had taken items in the past. The subject was not on scene and the clerk stated he no longer needed the police.
45. On 09/12/2020 at 12:58pm officers were dispatched to a Fight at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The officer interviewed the store clerk, who stated a female took items from the store without paying for them. The subject was in the store with merchandise. The clerk asked the subject to buy the items or put them down. The subject put down the items and left the store. The officer did not locate the subject.

47. On 09/18/2020 at 10:20am officers were dispatched to a Theft at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The applicant was on scene and stated a subject had stolen a gas can and gasoline. The applicant provided the officers with a license plate. The officers went to the location and were able to contact the suspect, who returned the merchandise. The applicant stated he did not want to prosecute since the subject returned the items.

48. On 09/22/2020 at 6:36pm officers were dispatched to a Robbery at the BP Gas Station, 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The officers interviewed the clerk, who stated two subjects came into the locked employee area by using a key. The subject demanded and obtained money, cigarettes and lottery tickets. The clerk provided the officers with video of the incident.

49. On 10/19/2020 at 12:00pm a meeting was held at District 3 regarding the increased violent crime at Lisbon BP, 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The applicant and the owner, Kalim BEG were at the meeting. BEG stated that he has plans to expand the register area, to allow the clerks to identify problems sooner. He stated they have hired armed security from 7pm-3am but stopped it at the beginning of the pandemic. BEG stated he was looking into increasing outside lighting and outside cameras. The officers suggested increased signage advising no loitering. On 10/20/2020 the officers conducted a site visit. They found adequate outside lighting but the windows of the business were obstructed with merchandise signs preventing the clerks from seeing out. They also only observed one sign stating No Loitering.

Items 36 and 37 updated with disposition on 11/02/2021

50. On 10/22/2020 at 12:15am officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The caller had stated a subject was at the business harassing customers and he was armed with a knife. The officers located the subject, who denied harassing customers. He agreed to leave the property. The clerk stated he just started work and the prior clerk was the caller.

51. On 11/11/2020 at 4:07pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The officers interviewed the clerk, who stated a subject had been outside panhandling and customers were complaining. The clerk stated the subject left prior to the arrival of the police.

52. On 11/22/2020 at 12:48pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. When the officer arrived they were informed the subject had left.

53. On 06/02/2021 at 12:52am officers investigated an Armed Robbery that occurred at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The victim stated he was at the station and a subject pointed a firearm at him and made him get in a car. The car then drove off with the victim inside. The victim was released at 5500 W. North Av. where he called police. The officers went to the station and viewed video of the incident. The video showed the victim getting into the car while the suspect pumped gas. The suspect never displayed a firearm. The suspect gets in the car and they both drive off.

54. On 07/06/2021 at 3:45am officers were dispatched to an Armed Robbery at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. Officers interviewed the victim who stated he was robbed at gunpoint in the parking lot. The officers interviewed the clerk who did witness the incident. The clerk was not able to use the computer to view video of the incident. He stated the manager would be in at 9am and he could access the video.

55. On 10/26/2021 at 10:28pm officers responded to a Shot Spotter call of three rounds fired on the parking lot at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The officers did locate three shell casings on the parking lot. The officer spoke to the clerk, who observed a subject sitting in his car fire three shots in the air out his window. The vehicle then fled Southbound on N. 27th St. The officer observed the video of the incident. The video shows the passenger of the auto get out and point a gun at the station. The driver appears to try and take the gun away but the passenger fires shots in the air. Both subjects get in the car and it leaves the lot. The officers attempted to get a copy of the video but were unable to copy it. The officers left contact information so the business could email the video.
