Dear Ms. Ingram:

This is to notify you that on November 21, 2005 the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern license be denied based upon nonappearance, a police report, neighborhood objections and a finding of unfit location.

On November 23, 2005 you were sent a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern license in which the Committee recommended that your renewal application be denied. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of December 13, 2005 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections or to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Licenses Committee by a vote of twelve (12) Ayes, one (1) Noe and two (2) Excused to deny the renewal of your Class "B" Tavern license.
