

Substitute resolution approving levy-  
ing of assessments and construction of  
assessable public improvement proj-  
ects at various locations and appropri-  
ating funds for these purposes with the

City cost of these projects approved  
by this resolution is estimated to be  
\$3,373,500 for a total estimated cost  
of \$8,569,500.

Whereas, The Common Council of  
the City of Milwaukee adopted prelim-  
inary resolutions, determining it neces-  
sary and in the public interest to  
construct and levy special assessments  
for the following improvements:

**2nd Aldermanic District**  
**W. Winfield Ave. - A point**  
**east of N. 89th St. to N. 90th**  
**St. (Including N. 90th St. - W.**  
**Bender Rd. to W. Winfield Ave.)**  
**(ST211110136) File Number**  
**091129:** Asphalt pavement resurf-  
acing, replace curb and gutter, side-  
walk and driveway approaches where  
necessary, sodding (5 - 13-foot width  
of tree border area), and grading.  
(Assessable Reconstruction Paving  
Fund - \$6,000; Nonassessable Recon-  
struction Paving Fund - \$130,000).  
The total estimated cost for this project  
including the requested amount is  
\$141,000. This project is anticipated  
to be completed during the 2012  
construction season.

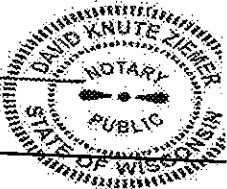
