

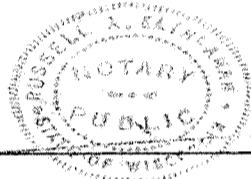

W. Medford Ave. - W. Hampton
Ave. to W. Grantosa Dr.
(ST211140140) File Number
141595: Asphalt pavement resurfacing,
replace curb and gutter,
sidewalk and driveway approaches
where necessary, sodding (7-foot
width of tree border area), and
grading. (Assessable Reconstruction
Paving Fund--\$13,000; Nonassessable
Reconstruction Paving
Fund -- \$330,000). The total
estimated cost for this project
including the requested amount is
\$383,000. This project is anticipated
to be completed during the 2015
construction season.

**N. 72nd St. - W. Congress St. to
W. Hampton Ave. (ST211140132)**
File Number 120369: Asphalt pavement
resurfacing, replace curb and
gutter, sidewalk and driveway ap-
proaches where necessary, sodding
(9-foot width of tree border area),
and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction
Paving Fund -- \$35,000;
Nonassessable Reconstruction
Paving Fund -- \$335,000). The total
estimated cost for this project
including the requested amount is
\$395,000. This project is anticipated
to be completed during the 2015
construction season.

estimated cost for this project
including the requested amount is
\$110,000. This project is anticipated
to be completed during the 2015
construction season.

150115: Concrete pavement reconstruction,
replace all curb and gutter,
replace sidewalk and driveway ap-
proaches where necessary, narrow
street from 50 feet to 48 feet,
sodding (8-foot width of tree border
area), and grading. (Assessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund --
\$67,000; Nonassessable Reconstruction
Paving Fund --
\$1,600,000). The total estimated
cost for this project including the
requested amount is \$1,700,000.
This project is anticipated to be
completed during the 2015 construction
season.
