This incident involved a traffic stop and citation on April 9, 1995 at approximately 6:35 p.m. The Fire and Police Commission dismissed the complaint. Attached is a copy of the dismissal notice.



ORDER OF DISMISSAL


To Officer Anthony Randazzo:




