Attached is the first progress report of 2007 for the Brewery Project LLC, the historic adaptive reuse of the former Pabst brewing site in the northwest corner of downtown Milwaukee. The report includes pictures of construction activities including environmental remediation (elimination of lead based paint, asbestos and other hazardous materials) and the removal of equipment, furniture and other materials from the interior. A high percentage of this material is being recycled. The pictures of buildings where remediation work has already taken place will give you an idea of the spectacular space that will be available for purchase by third parties for use as housing, offices, or retail space.

As the front door to downtown Milwaukee and the western anchor of the Park East corridor, we believe the ultimate success of The Brewery rests on our commitment to a sustainable neighborhood and giving priority to local merchants and vendors. We are working closely with our fellow developers in the Park East to aggressively market the entire corridor in the belief that when all of our projects are completed, The Brewery and its neighbors will truly serve as the gateway to downtown Milwaukee.

We are on schedule and on budget as submitted to the City of Milwaukee as part of our TIF application. We continue to aggressively market both the buildings and the vacant space on site. Interest is extremely high and we are guardedly optimistic that we will meet, or exceed our yearly projection for sales.

I am extremely pleased with our efforts to date. I hope you share my satisfaction with the job that is being done by our management, marketing and construction teams who are working very hard under extremely challenging circumstances to stay on budget.
