
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a representative of the Department of City Development of the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin (the “**Issuer**”) will hold a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. on December 5, 2006 in the First Floor Board Room at 809 North Broadway, Milwaukee, Wisconsin regarding the proposed issuance by the Issuer of industrial development revenue bonds pursuant to Section 66.1103, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, in a maximum aggregate face amount of \$2,500,000, on behalf of Pettit National Ice Center, Inc. (the “**Borrower**”), a Wisconsin nonprofit corporation. The proceeds of the bonds will be used to finance costs associated with the acquisition by Borrower of the recreational ice skating and Olympic training facility known as the Pettit National Ice Center located at 500 South 84th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Following the issuance of the bonds, the Borrower will be the owner and operator of the financed facility.

The public hearing will be conducted in a manner that provides a reasonable opportunity to be heard for persons with differing views on both issuance of the bonds and the location and nature of the facility. Any person desiring to be heard on this matter is requested to attend the public hearing or send a representative. Written comments (not exceeding 250 words) may be presented at the hearing if submitted in advance to the Director of the Department of City Development.

Comments made at the hearing are for the consideration of the Common Council of the Issuer but do not bind any legal action to be taken by them.
