
All wood must be painted or stained with an opaque stain.




Existing conditions



Existing conditions—Detail Retain existing gate or replace as below


2555 N. Summit Ave, Milwaukee, WI Wall Material for:

Wall Material

- -Stone is (8) inches deep x (6) inches tall.
- -Length of pieces are (12) to (36) inches long.
- -Wall will be a dried layed re-enforced with geo-grid. -Every course will have up to 1/4" setback.



New fencing and gate style. Wood must be painted or stained with an opaque stain.
