



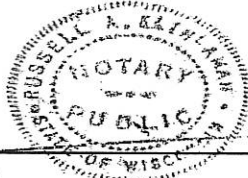

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to law, the City Plan Commission will hold a public hearing on Monday, October 2nd, 2017, at 3:00 p.m. in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, at which time persons interested in the creation of the following Neighborhood Improvement District, will be given an opportunity to be heard:

Establishment of the boundary of Neighborhood Improvement District No. 9 (Havenwoods) and approval of its Initial Operating Plan for the area generally bounded by N. 55th Place and goes to N. 76th St from Silver Spring Drive through Kaul Avenue with the following exclusions being public spaces and industrial uses: Carmen to Kaul Avenue from N. 55th St. to N. 60th St. and Florist to Kaul Avenue from 64th St. to 73rd St, in the 2nd and 9th Aldermanic Districts.
