Dear Mr. Givionte Mull:

This is to notify you that on Tuesday, April 28, 2026, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to renew with a 20 (twenty) day suspension your Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, aldermanic, applicant and neighborhood testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations; for the premises located at 5938-40 N 76TH St. ("LUSH SOCIAL LOUNGE").

On May 1, 2026, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses, in which the Committee recommended renewal with a 20 (twenty) day suspension of your Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, aldermanic, applicant and neighborhood testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting on Tuesday, May 12, 2026 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. On that date, time, and place, you did file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee, you did not appear in person and you were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to renew with a 20 (twenty) day suspension your Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, aldermanic, applicant and neighborhood testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations. Said suspension is in effect between 12:01 a.m. on May 12, 2026 until 11:59 p.m. on May 31, 2026.


Dear Ms. Ciara A. Jarrett:


