for these purposes with the City
cost of these projects approved by
this resolution is estimated to be
\$3,738,706.20 for a total estimated
cost of \$13,333,047.29.

Whereas, The Common Council
of the City of Milwaukee adopted
preliminary resolutions, determin-
ing it necessary and in the public
interest to construct and levy special
assessments for the following
improvements:

1st Aldermanic District
N. 23rd St. - W. Ruby Ave.
to W. Cornell St. (ST211230105)
File Number 221683: Concrete
pavement reconstruction, replace
all curb and gutter, and drive-
way approaches, replace sidewalk
where necessary, sodding (7' width
of tree border area), tree removal
as necessary, grading, storm
drainage facilities, and permeable
pavement as necessary. (Assessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund
-- \$46,590; Nonassessable Recon-
struction Paving Fund -- \$410,000).
The total estimated cost for this
project including the requested
amount is \$470,000. This project is
anticipated to be completed during
the 2024 construction season.

220993: Concrete alley pavement

Water St. (ST211230140), N. Pros-
pect Ave. (ST211230124) will be
billed after January 1, 2026, but not
before 12 months after the project
contract has been completed.
