File # 021112 is a resolution relative to the application, acceptance and funding of a "Click It-Why Risk It" Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a *Click It Why Risk It* project grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety.
- 2. This is a continuing grant.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of this grant project is the enforcement of safety belt/safety seat usage, and speeding and driving (drug and alcohol) impaired enforcement.
- 2. This grant encompasses the period of November 1, 2002 through April 30, 2003.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$11,613 with \$8,000 (69%) provided by the grantor and \$3,613 (31%) provided by the city. The city share of this grant will be supplied through the MPD operating budget.
- 2. \$4,000 of the *total* grant will be applied to MPD personnel overtime relative to traffic enforcement and seatbelt/safety seat usage.
- 3. \$4,000 of the grant is budgeted for the purchase of a laser speed-recording unit.
- 4. \$3,613 is the MPD *in-kind* share that includes fringe benefits and indirect costs.
