Dear Ms. Barbian:

This is to notify you that on September 4, 2008, the City's Public Safety Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your public passenger vehicle permit numbers 174, 175 and 176 for luxury limousines be revoked based upon the complaint of Richard Pfaff and your nonappearance.

On September 16, 2008, you were sent a true and correct copy of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendations of the Public Safety Committee with respect to your public passenger vehicle permit numbers 174, 175 and 176. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of October 7, 2008, commencing at 9:00 a.m., in the Common Council chambers, on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did not appear and you did not file written objections to the report of the Public Safety Committee.

Following consideration of the report of the Public Safety Committee, the Common Council adopted the Committee's recommendation by a vote of fourteen (14) ayes, zero (0) noes, and one (1) excused to adopt the recommendation of the Public Safety Committee to revoke your public passenger vehicle permit numbers 174, 175 and 176 based upon the complaint and nonappearance.
