 - Sanitation Supervisor (3)
 - Operations Driver/Worker (11)
 - Office Assistant IV (1)
- Operating Expenditures include:
 - Increased Other Operating Supplies \$696,400
 - Increased Tipping Fees by \$2,050,000

Other Policy & Service Issues Sanitation

Solid Waste Enhancements

- Second Clean and Green added
 - Operates four weeks during September
 - Opportunity to dispose of items unable to set out or missed during the Spring Clean and Green
- Saturday collections
 - Guarantees seven day garbage pick up during summer months
 - Wrapped around three summer holidays

2010 Proposed Changes/Issues Sanitation

- No Outside of Cart
 - Generates savings of approximately \$1.4 million
 - Eliminates 10 summer routes
 - Begins June 1, 2010
 - Generates \$1.7 million in 2011
- Self Help
 - Will be closed on Wednesdays
 - Will no longer accept construction debris free of charge
 - Based on size of vehicles
 - Full cost recovery
 - Reduces approximately \$600,000 from property tax levy
- Summer Curbside Set Out
 - Generates savings of approximately \$152,000
 - Reduces recycling routes from 34 to 29 for eight months
- No Capital Projects in the 2010 proposed budget
