1. Description of Grant Program/Project (Include Target Locations and Populations):

These grant funds will be used to temporarily expand tuberculosis (TB) testing and screening services in Milwaukee County, including for participants of the Uniting for Ukraine (U4U) program. Milwaukee County has the highest number of U4U sponsors in Wisconsin and TB continues to disproportionately affect foreign born and disadvantaged members of the Milwaukee community, including those recently arrived from Ukraine through the U4U program.

Other Milwaukee County health departments have experienced significant barriers to getting individuals, including U4U participants, access to TB screening services. Fortunately, MHD is uniquely positioned to offer expanded county-wide services and receive referrals from other local health departments and organizations in Milwaukee County.

2. Relationship to Citywide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

This program relates to the City-wide goal to enhance the health and well-being of Milwaukee residents by improving access to preventive health care; promote healthy behaviors; reduce racial and ethnic health disparities; and improve the quality of healthcare information and coordination of services.

The TB U4U grant will fund an additional Public Health Nurse position in order to provide county-wide services. Community-wide, these grants work to improve the health of Milwaukee's citizens.
