### **FY2021 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG)**

**Grant Type:** Amending FY2021 JAG Grant File 220421

**Grantor:** US Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs Bureau of Justice Assistance

**Grant Period:** October 1, 2020 - September 30, 2024

**Award Amount:** Supplemental award of \$482,056 will increase total award from \$392,607 to \$874,663 (\$874,663 from Grantor, \$0 from City)

**Award Allocations:** City of Milwaukee \$508,748; City of West Allis \$21,380; Milwaukee County \$344,535

**Match Required:** None

**Allocation Purpose:** The City of Milwaukee will serve as the fiscal agent for the JAG Program on behalf of the City of West Allis and Milwaukee County with allocations for all units of local governments to be used to support criminal justice activities.

**Program Goal:** The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to local governments. The balance of the FY2021 JAG is awarded to the City of Milwaukee as part of the transfer to the City as the fiscal agent on behalf of the City of West Allis and Milwaukee County. The City's allocation of \$508,748 of the total \$874,663 award (\$21,380 allocated to City of West Allis and \$344,535 allocated to Milwaukee County) will fund the Milwaukee Community Justice Council Executive Director; and partially fund the cell site simulator and 5G enabler.
