The Common Council has referred to the City Plan Commission for recommendation on File No. 051671 and 051670 being ordinances relating to the change in zoning from Industrial Mixed (IM), Two-Family Residential (RT4) and Parks (PK) to a General Planned Development (GPD) and approval of the Phase 1, Detailed Planned Development (DPD) on land located on the North Side of East North Avenue and East of North Humboldt Avenue, in the 3rd Aldermanic District. These ordinances allow for a mixed-use development including a student housing building, residential condominiums and commercial retail. The first phase of development includes approval of a 5-6 story University of Wisconsin Milwaukee student housing building with 119 units just north of E. 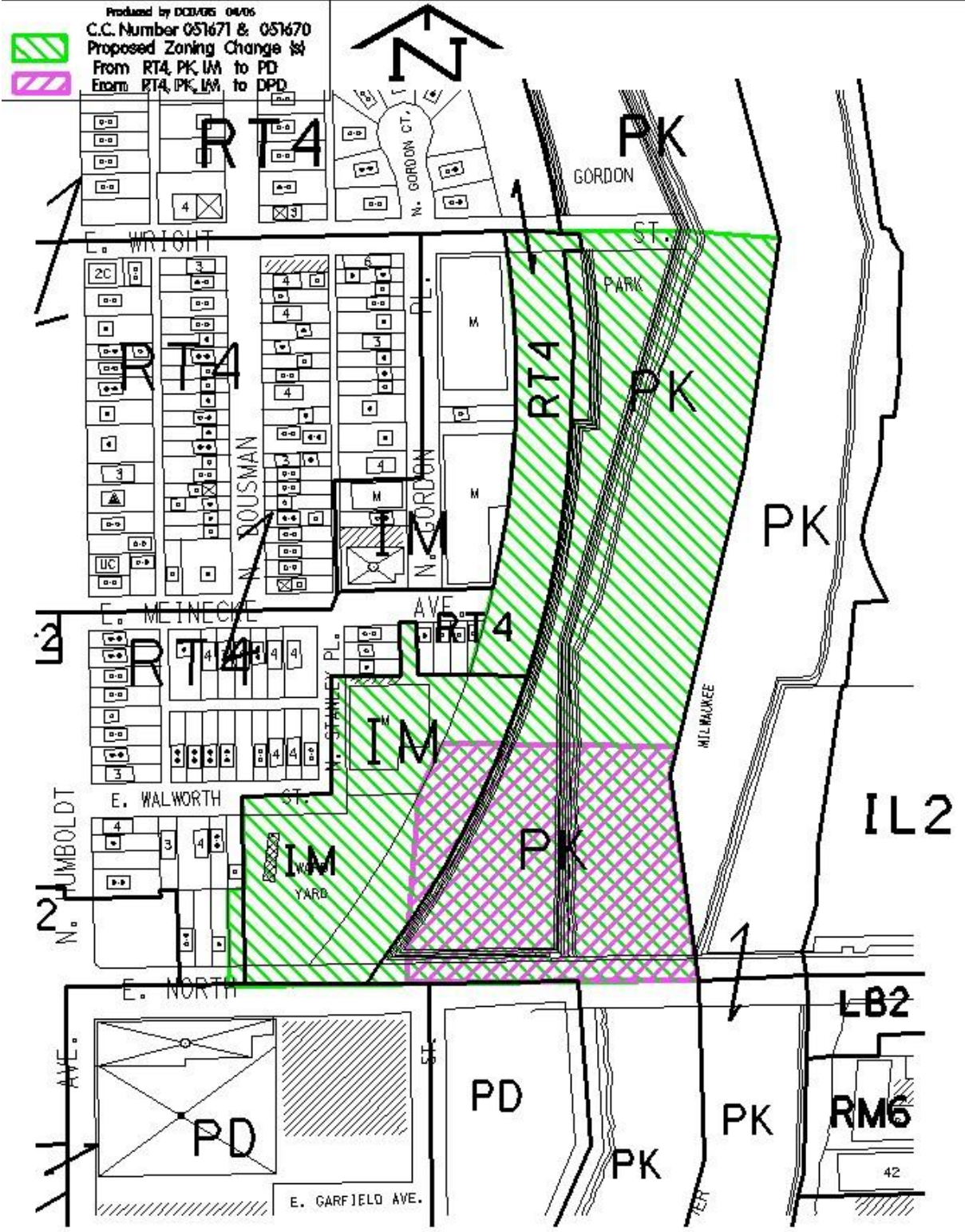
