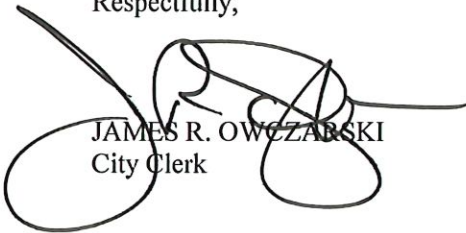
This is to notify you that on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council not to renew your Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses based upon your second nonappearance; for the premises located at 182 E LINCOLN Av. ("BROWN & GIBBS SPORTS BAR").

On June 11, 2026, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses, in which the Committee recommended nonrenewal of your Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses based upon your second nonappearance. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting on Tuesday, June 23, 2026 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. On that date, time, and place, you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee, you did not appear in person and you were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted not to renew your Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses based upon your second nonappearance

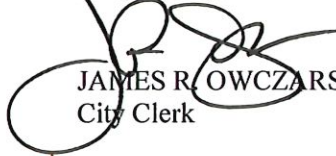
This is to notify you that on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to renew with a 30 (thirty) day suspension your Extended Hours Establishment license based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety, or welfare of the public and for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations; for the premises located at 3801 S 27TH St. ("DENNY'S #8092").

On June 11, 2026, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Extended Hours Establishment license, in which the Committee recommended renewal with a 30 (thirty) day suspension of your Extended Hours Establishment license based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety, or welfare of the public and for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations. Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to renew with a 10 (ten) day suspension your Extended Hours Establishment license based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety, or welfare of the public and for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations.

Said suspension is in effect between 12:01 a.m. on June 23, 2026 until 11:59 p.m. on July 2, 2026.
