  - ► Appeals/ Jury Demands to Circuit Court
  - ► Property Return Cases

### Reckless Driving Initiative

- April 2024: Renewed Focus on Reckless Driving
- New strategy:
  - ▶ No reductions on <u>provable</u> cases of reckless driving
  - Prosecute all Reckless Driving to fullest extent of law
  - ► Greater utility of criminal charge under Wis. Stat. § 346.65(1)(b)
- October 2024: New Strategy Announced to Community


### Elevated Review and Training

- Hard line on reckless driving requires investment in quality control
- Officer Training
  - Provided training on types of evidence/reporting required
- Elevated review of all reckless driving cases by OED attorneys
  - ▶ 1. Formal Sufficiency of Charging Document
  - ▶ 2. Sufficiency of Evidence
    - ▶ Must be Provable by Clear and Convincing Evidence


### Case Review Statistics

- # Cases Rejected: 23


# Total Reckless Driving First Offense Filings per Year

#### Notable Statutes

- ▶ Wis. Stat. § 346.62(2)
  - ▶ No person may endanger the safety of any person or property by the negligent operation of a vehicle.
- ▶ Wis. Stat. § 346.65 Penalty for violating sections 346.62 to 346.64
  - (1)(b) May be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 or imprisoned for not more than one year in the county jail or both for a 2nd or subsequent violation.


#### RECKLESS DRIVING ELEMENTS

- The defendant operated a vehicle on a highway.
- The defendant operated a vehicle in a manner constituting <u>criminal</u> <u>negligence</u>.
- 3. The defendant's criminal negligence endangered the safety of any person or property.

#### CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE Means:

- the defendant's operation of a vehicle created a risk of death or great bodily harm; and
- the risk of death or great bodily harm was unreasonable and substantial; and
- the defendant should have been aware that (his) (her) operation of a vehicle created the unreasonable and substantial risk of death or great bodily harm.

# Current Reckless Driving 1st Penalty



### Potential Bases for Dismissal

- Officer fails to appear @ trial
- Material citizen witness fails to appear/ refuses to testify
- New Exculpatory Evidence
  - ▶ Re: Identification
  - ▶ Re: Elements of Offense
- Suppression of Evidence (pursuant to motion to suppress)
- Exclusion of Evidence (pursuant to Ct. ruling re: admissibility)
- Part of larger plea deal
