There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

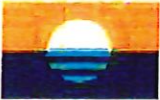

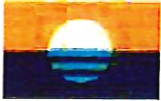

8. On 10/29/24 at 12:56a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check. The officer spoke to the owner who stated it was their grand opening and they plan to run the business more like a restaurant. Further stated they will have 8-9 security guards, will be making people leave ½ hour before bar close and security will be escorting patrons to their vehicles.
9. On 12/29/24 at 12:00a.m, Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check. The Agent was on scene and provided with security, noise and flow of traffic suggestions. While the officer was on scene a noise complaint came in, however, the officer observed it was due to traffic in the area, not the business.
10. On 01/20/25 at 5:55p.m., Milwaukee Police took a Walk-in Battery, that occurred between 01/18/25 11:00p.m., and 01/19/25 12:15a.m. The victim stated they were strangled inside the business, then struck on the head with a glass bottle outside, causing them to receive stitches. The victim stated they requested video from the business, however, were told they did not have video surveillance.
11. On 02/20/25 at 11:30p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting. On arrival officers interviewed a security officer, who had a holster, however was unarmed. The security guard stated they heard an argument in front of the business, then two shots fired. The security denied knowing who fired the shot, however, one casing was recovered under their vehicle. Two victims stated they were kicked out of the business, and a physical fight took place outside, when the owner pointed a gun at their group, and other staff retrieved firearms from inside and shot at them. A co-owner arrived on scene, however, stated they had to leave due to child care issues. The Agent arrived on scene and stated they recently had video surveillance installed, however, did not know the password. The Agent provided officers with a phone number for the installer, however, it went to voicemail. The officers noted management and staff were uncooperative with officers initially. No victim was located.
12. On 03/04/25 at 5:35p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted follow up at the business regarding an illegal dumping complaint. Officers attempted to interview a manager, however, they were uncooperative and refused to allow officers to view video surveillance. The manager appeared hostile toward officers.
13. On 03/09/25 at 1:39a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. Officers interviewed the intoxicated caller who stated an employee hit them in the back of the head, however, changed their story a few times. An employee stated the subject was not assaulted and only escorted out. The employee stated officers could review video surveillance but asked the officer to come back later as they were busy. The officer was unable to return to the location.
14. On 03/13/25 at 11:09p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon. On arrival officers interviewed the parties involved who stated it was a verbal argument in the parking lot and nothing took place inside the business. Both parties left the scene with no further incident.
15. On 04/25/25 at 8:24p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check regarding an Aldermanic Complaint about cones in the street in front of the location. Officers advised security to move the cones off the street, but remained in the area and observed an employee arrive and put the cones back. The officers returned and advised the employee, who became argumentative about removing the cones, however, eventually moved the cones to the curb.

16. On 05/09/25 at 6:00p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Traffic Hazard. Officers found 10-15 cones in the street in front of the business. Officers spoke to two employees and advised them to move the cones, however, they refused to move them. The officer began to move them and one of the subjects stated they would put them back as soon as police left. The officer issued a citation for the violation, however, as of the date of this report, I was unable to locate it.

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The following items pertain to 4747 N Hopkins

17. On 10/06/25 at 12:34a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint. On arrival the business was closed, and no loud music could be heard, however, it should be noted the original call came in on 10/05/25 at 10:31p.m.

18. On 03/31/26 at 8:37p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check. On arrival the officers observed 3 loaded AR style rifles in a booth approximately 10 feet from where a customer was seated. A search warrant was executed in which 3 semi-automatic rifles, and 3 semi-automatic pistols were confiscated. One of the pistols was located inside a freezer. The Agent was on scene and provided receipts for the Liquor, however, it did not cover the amount of stock on site. The manager arrived on scene and was arrested for Felon in Possession.

On March 31, 2026 at approximately 8:37pm, PO Jordan OSSANNA-REHL and PO Angel GALLEGOS (Squad 7570), PO Alexander DEY and PO Jamahl WRIGHT (Squad 7282), PO Ricky LOZANO and PO Fernando SANTIAGO CRUZ (Squad 7441), PO Steven MENGE and PO David MICHAELS (Squad 7280), TEU Williams MAUCH (Squad 769) and TEU Antwan Powell (Squad 769), TEU Sgt. Joseph SCHEURING (Squad 716), Sgt. Steven PUGELY (Squad 7512) and my partner PO Theodore CHANDLER and I were dispatched to 4747 N Hopkins Street to assist with the audit and inspections of liquor and licenses. The other outside jurisdiction members included Wisconsin Division of Alcohol Beverages, Special Agent Holly MCMANUS and Compliance Agents from the IRS.

Upon arrival, I observed Options and Restaurant Lounge to be open for business. I observed approximately thirty customers located inside Options and Restaurant Lounge. Special MCMANUS spoke with the owner Sheila T NGUYEN F/B (11/02/1984) who was observed behind the bar serving customers. MCMANUS asked to see NGUYEN Permits, which were not displayed in a public spot, which is required by law. Upon TEU Sgt. SCHEURING and TEU officers POWELL entering the establishment they observed three AR Rifle style firearms located in an unsecured security booth. These three rifles was approximately ten feet away from where customers sitting prior to our arrival. All rifles were loaded with one unspent cartridge in the chamber. I observed all three rifles to not have any type of safety lock located on the firearms. Once the rifles were located on the scene was immediately froze the scene and a search warrant was written.

While we waited for the search warrant to get signed. We had all the customers leave the lounge. We then identified each of the following employees.

Bartender / owner - Shelia NGUYEN A/F (11/02/1984)
Server -Selesio T FORNEY A/F (04/26/2008)
Cook - Semadriyuon D Battle B/M (07/12/1994)
Hookah - Deidre L UEAL (06/25/1994)

Cook - William Taber B/M (05/29/1983)
Security - Playreo D Cole B/M (03/09/1993)

At approximately 9:59pm the search warrant was signed by Judge John Remington. The a copy of the search warrant was given to NGUYEN. It at this time that all members of the Milwaukee Police Department and members of Department of Wisconsin Revenue Division conducted a search of Options and Restaurant Lounge. During this search several receipts were located from Badgers Distribution for Kinky's Tavern. The amount of invoices that were on site did not cover the amount of stock that was on site.

You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
