There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

It has just been brought to my attention that there is a bar or club called Reign opening up in the Third Ward a few blocks from my address. 1) We were not given notification in my building, , yet we are greatly affected by this establishment that is within a few blocks. 2) Please send these notices to our building so that we may contest it or share our objections, or offer support as needed.

ris greatly affected by activities in the neighborhood, and crime has been on the rise. Ald Bauman may recall my opposition to Site 1A, which was completely out of control. During those hearings, I shared the disturbances and highlighted that those willing to commit crimes in the open (common and documented with the city). Said individuals certainly noticed there was a lack of police presence in a previously very safe neighborhood. At those hearings I stated crime would go up if it was not immediately resolved at that time, and the concerns were largely dismissed (Ald Bauman has been very supportive and was not one who dismissed the concerns). Now we have homicides, shootings, our was just broken into with property theft, and cars are broken into multiple times a month in the lot next door. I would invite anyone to sit down at the corner of Water and Erie and observe between 10pm-1am and let me know if you think adding a club to the neighborhood is a sound idea. At a time when we are very thin on police numbers, it is concerning that we may have another similar club (to Site 1A) opening in the neighborhood that will lead to continued problems. Please note, I am happy to be wrong here if the intended venue is meant to be a relaxed lounge and if so would withdraw any objection; however, it is my understanding that it will be a dance club.

I appreciate that the Third Ward is probably coming off as a bit obstinate as it relates to entertainment venues. However, in order to maintain the delicate balance between residential and business, and keep the neighborhood as a Milwaukee go-to destination, we unfortunately require additional scrutiny of venues that have the potential to add to the crime burden of the neighborhood.

I am a condo owner in the Historic Third Ward at

I am writing to object to the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premise of Reign at 231 N Buffalo. From the letter I received from the City of Milwaukee, which mentions DJ's and a dancing, this sounds very similar to a club. The person filing, Shamia B. Washington, also owns another club in Milwaukee, so safe to assume this is a club.

We just finally were able to rid the neighborhood of the unsafe conditions that Site 1A caused, most recently the shooting outside of my window on Buffalo/Broadway. I am not sure why we would consider allowing another similar establishment. Reign will be another safety issue in our neighborhood, including fights outside and around the bar, violence, unsafe driving througout the neighborhood (which is a huge safety issue and innitiative for Milwaukee right now). It will cause noise pollution, and probably also litter and trash the neighborhood.

I want to make it clear my first and foremost issue with Reign is the safety issue. After the murder right up the street from me, Site 1A was finally shut down. Why would we immediately allow another similar establishment?

- 2. On 02/20/2019 at 2:56am officers were dispatched to a Battery complaint at Site 1A, 231 E. Buffalo St. The officers interviewed the victim, who stated she saw an ex-boyfriend in the bar. She stated he was upset she was there and began throwing drinks. Security attempted to throw the subject out but he ran away. The applicant was on scene and stated the subject is a regular customer. He was the subject throwing drinks and advised security to throw him out but he ran away.
- 3. On 03/13/2019 at 1:40am officers were monitoring Site 1A, 231 E. Buffalo St. The officers observed security outside of the club, but stated they did not take any action to clear the crowd or ask them to keep the noise down. The officers spoke with the applicant, who stated he had given security a plan of action but they did not follow it. He stated he would address the situation with them.

- 4. On 10/18/2019 an officer received a complaint at desk regarding loud music coming from Site 1A. The caller lives a block away and stated the music is a constant problem, sometimes vibrating his windows. An officer responded to the location and could hear music outside as he pulled up. The officer also observed the side door standing open.
- 5. On 10/31/2019 an officer received a complaint at the desk regarding loud music from Site 1A. the caller stated this is an ongoing problem, throughout the week and he cannot get any sleep. An officer responded to the location and could hear loud music from over a block away, rattling windows. The applicant was on scene and issued a citation.

- 6. On 12/10/2019 officers, along with agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a license premise check at Site 1A, 231 E. Buffalo St. the officers located 17 bottles of liquor contaminated with fruit flies. They also located a liquor bottle that appeared to be refilled. The manager, Michael BYERS-DENT, was advised to dispose of the contaminated bottles.
- 7. On 05/27/2020 officers were dispatched to a Noise Nuisance at Site 1A 231 E. Buffalo St. Upon arrival the officers observed a subject taking out trash from the building. They explained why they were there and she called the applicant. The applicant came down the elevator and stated he was having a private party on the roof for a friend that just passed away. The officers went to the roof with the applicant and observed 19 people and open bottles of alcohol. They also observed liquor bottles with pour spouts, which are commonly used in bars. The applicant stated all the alcohol was privately purchased and he could provide receipts, which he was no able to locate. The applicant was advised to keep the music down and that this report would be filed.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

The following applies to corporate officer Vietor Isaj:

On 02/08/02, Isaj was charged with Battery and Criminal Damage to Property by Cudahy Police Department. On 04/05/02, the charge of battery was amended to Disorderly Conduct and he was found guilty and fined. There was no disposition reported on the criminal damage charge.

1. On 10/19/12 at 11:00 pm, Milwaukee police, along with members of Department of Neighborhood services, conducted a License Premise Check at 231 E Buffalo Street. Officers walked through the bar and did a rough count of about 140 patrons in the bar. When officers asked an employee working the door how many people were in the club and if he had a clicker with the exact amount of patrons, the employee working the door could not provide the officer with the count, nor did he possess a clicker with the count. Officers then spoke with Jared Siemers and brought to his attention that his license allows him to only operate till 1:30 am. Siemers stated that this was wrong and the officer asked Siemers to show him the license showing otherwise. Siemers provided his license where it showed his business must be closed by 1:30 am. Siemers continued to say this was wrong and asked to remain open till 2:30 am. Siemers was advised he could not and must close at time the license stated. Officers returned to the business at 1:30 am and observed the bar just starting to get patrons out of the establishment. At 1:50 am, the bar was free of patrons. A verbal warning was issued to the bar owner that in accordance with their license, all patrons must be out of the bar at 1:30 am and no later.

#### Page 2 Siemers, Jared J

2. On 10/21/12 at 1:00 am, Milwaukee police went to 231 E Buffalo to meet with the owners and licensee regarding the hours of closing on their Class B Tavern license. Jared Siemers, along with Attorney Michael Whitcomb, were there and contended that the hours on the license was a typo by the city clerk and went on to say that they city can not modify the closing time of 2:30 am, as set by the State. A police sergeant advised them that for the time being, they needed to follow the terms stated on their license and close at 1:30 am. Attorney Whitcomb stated that his clients would be taking the citation for patrons after hours and remain open till 2:30 am. The police sergeant advised the Whitcomb that Siemers would not only be cited for patrons after hours, but police would also shut them down. Siemers, along with his partner, Sean Pliss, stated they would close at 1:30 am and would take care of licensing issues on Monday morning.

At 1:50 am, Milwaukee police went to 231 E Buffalo to verify that they were closed. Police observed a large group of people milling about on the sidewalk in front of the business and when officers drove by, observed a full bar with a large number of patrons inside. Police conducted a license premise check and observed patrons to be dancing and drinking. The DJ was still playing music and the bartenders were still serving. A police sergeant responded to the bar and ordered a count of patrons, which was found to be 167 patrons. A count of employees was also done and found to be at 23. Capacity posted was 170. Seimers was advised that citations would be issued for over capacity and patrons after hours.

- 4. On 02/19/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 231 East Buffalo Street (Oak Lounge) and dropped off a packet of tavern related ordinances.
- 5. On 03/06/2015 a 19 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to Oak's (231 East Buffalo) but was denied when she could not provide proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.




# City Concentration Map - 231 E BUFFALO ST




