Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers David Martinez, Alex Mantay, Alex Lopez, Jr., Nick Povolo and Eric Dillman. The claim is in the amount of \$2,618.93 including \$22.93 in disbursements for 23.60 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

This incident involved the arrest of a subject with outstanding warrants.


The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled POs Post, Neitman, Martinez Lopez, Povolo and Dillman to give statements concerning the incident after issuing PI-21s.

Later, the MPD decided not to issue criminal charges against the officers. Attached is a copy of the clearance report and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

INVESTIGATIVE NARRATIVE:

This report is being dictated by Detective Michael CARLSON, of the Criminal Investigation Unit/Internal Affairs Division (CIU/IAD), day shift.

On Wednesday, May 23, 2001, I interviewed the complainant and she stated that she had been struck in the left eye with a closed fist by an unknown Milwaukee police officer while standing on the porch at her residence. At the time of the reporting I could not see any injuries to her eye and she stated to me that there were none at this time. Upon further investigation it was learned that on the early morning hours of 05-23-01, Sgt. DAVID MUEHL of District #7 interviewed the complainant, regarding her complaint.

At this time Sgt. MUEHL reports that she initially stated that she was struck in the eye by a metal baton wheeled by an officer. When Sgt. MUEHL questioned her regarding her injuries and the fact that there were none she then changed her story to that she was struck in the eye with a fist. Sgt. MUEHL subsequently had photos taken of her. On 06-14-01, I did obtain these photos from the Milwaukee Police Department photo lab and upon viewing them could not see any injuries to the complainant's left eye.

Given the fact that the complainant has no injuries and made two different statements as to what occurred, I am unable to prove that a battery occurred to her. Due to these facts this complaint will be cleared as unfounded.
