### 310.20 BICYCLE PATROL

#### D. OFFICER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

4. Members who are no longer assigned to bicycle patrol or listed as a designated bicycle member shall turn in all designated equipment and uniforms including:
  - a. The ~~bicycle uniform and equipment (including nylon duty belt)~~ (including nylon magazine pouches, nylon expandable baton holder, nylon Oleoresin Capsicum canister holster, etc.) to the Police Academy quartermaster;
7. Members are prohibited from storing their department issued bicycle at any location other than their assigned work location without the permission of the department bicycle supervisor.

**Note:** An exception to this policy can be made if the member is not reporting back to their work location after the assignment from which the bicycle was used (e.g., extra-duty or special event employment). The member must immediately bring the bicycle back for the next tour of duty at the member's assigned work location.
