Dear Administrative Review Board of Appeals:

Enclosed for review, relative to the appeal of the above-captioned matter, are redacted materials related to the nuisance activity identified in the nuisance determination notice.

By letter dated October 15, 2024, the Milwaukee Police Department sent written notice that 4937 N. 39th St. is determined to be a nuisance pursuant to Milwaukee City Ordinance (MCO) § 80-10. The letter identified two shootings that qualify as nuisance activity pursuant to MCO § 80-10-2-c-1-Q. This ordinance subsection refers to another ordinance that prohibits the discharge of firearms in the City. MCO § 105-35.

The first shooting occurred on August 19, 2024. Materials have been enclosed as Exhibit A. The letter mistakenly stated August 18, 2024, but the computer-aided dispatch number is noticed for a shooting that occurred at this location on August 19, 2024. The police report identifies the crime as a 1st-Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety.

It should be noted that non-fatal shootings are frequently criminally prosecuted as Recklessly Endangering Safety in violation of Wis. Stat. § 941.30. This criminal violation is also a nuisance activity pursuant to MCO § 80-10-c-1-k. This specific nuisance activity is a type that qualifies for two responses in a year. MCO § 80-10-3-a.



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The first shooting was relayed, in part, by F.C. who lived in a unit at this premises. F.C. stated that D.D. is her fiancé and J.S. is her ex-boyfriend. F.C. said a truck is going to be transferred to her, but it is still registered to J.S.'s ex-wife L.C.S. It is also reported that J.S. has a new girlfriend named S.L.W.

F.C. stated that, a few days prior to the shooting, J.S. and S.L.W. were using the truck and, the day after, it was reported that the truck was at S.L.W.'s uncle's house for repairs. When J.S. called the uncle, it was stated that the truck was not there. It does not appear that the truck was ever reported stolen.

On the day of the shooting, they observed the truck in the area of a McDonald's that they were walking towards. J.S. ran ahead to talk with the occupants of the truck. F.C. and D.D. asked for the truck back, but that request was declined.

F.C. and D.D. returned to 4937 N. 39th St. and they stated that the truck, with four armed males, arrived at the premises a few hours later. The group went to the hallway area of the premises and then left. The group reportedly came back thirty minutes later. Three men exited the truck and one of them fired rounds at F.C. and D.D.

Another witness, L.W., is D.D.'s mother and she observed the shooting. She said she looked out and saw her son's truck. She said after the shooting, the vehicle drove away and stopped at the first intersection. S.L.W. was dropped off at this intersection.

S.L.W. was interviewed and she said she was dropped off prior to the shooting. She said the occupants of the truck were cocaine dealers. She said the truck belonged to a Hispanic male and the truck was a drug rental.

The second shooting occurred on October 12, 2024. Materials have been enclosed as Exhibit B. A man died from gunshot wounds and a woman was shot in the left arm.

The CAD stated that the event location is 4937 N 39th St. and a caller states that two girls were fighting and a man came out and shot him. It was stated that F.D. was part of the altercation and fled the scene. The altercation started inside of the apartment building and officers conducted a canvass of this location. Officers waited at Apartment 10 for the board-up. The suspected primary address of F.D. was 4937 N. 39th St., Apt. #10.

An interview of P.N.E. stated that they saw a woman call their daughters to the address to fight. The fight occurred in front of the residence. A man exited 4937 N. 39th St. and shot victims. An interview of M.S.W. stated that she called women to her apartment because she believed another woman stole clothes from her apartment. She said the fight occurred in front of the residence.

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Third, assessing the cost of police activity against the owner of the premises does not violate any Constitutional rights. There is no possibility that the regulation will chill protected activity because there is no constitutional right to police services. *Hilton v. City of Wheeling*, 209 F.3d 1005, 1006–07 (7th Cir. 2000).

Finally, Exhibit C shows Youssef Berrada or his company have been the owner of the premises throughout the incidents.

Re: Notice of Nuisance Premises

Dear: BERRADA PROPERTIES 125 LLC

This letter is notice to you that the Milwaukee Chief of Police, by the chief's designee, the district commander, has determined that the premises located at 4937 N. 39th Street., ("the premises") is a nuisance pursuant to Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("MCO") 80-10, Chronic Nuisance Premises.

The Milwaukee Police Department has responded to the following described nuisance activities at the premises on the corresponding dates, which qualify the premises as a nuisance:

1. On August 18, 2024, at 4:18 pm an emergency call for service was created for the above listed premise which resulted in the response of the Milwaukee Police Department. This call for service was given a computer-aided dispatch #P2408191065. We were sent to 4937 N 39th St for a Shooting. This is a violation of MCO-80-10-2-C-1-Q
2. On October 12, 2024, at 2:45pm an emergency call for service was created for the above listed premise which resulted in the response of the Milwaukee Police Department. This call for service was given a computer-aided dispatch #P2410120851. We were sent to 4945 N 39th St for a Shooting. Subsequent investigations revealed that the incident originated at 4937 N 39th St#10. This is a violation of MCO-80-10-2-C-1-Q

As a consequence, the premises may be subject to a special charge for the cost of future enforcement for any of the nuisance activities listed in MCO 80-10-2-c that occur at the premises.

You are directed to respond to my office within 10 days of receipt of this notice with an acceptable, written course of action that you will undertake to abate the nuisance activities occurring at the premises or file an appeal. You may appeal this nuisance determination to the

Administrative Review Appeals Board. Any appeal must be in writing and a processing fee will be charged. Please contact the Office of the City Clerk at (414) 286-2231 for additional information.

If you timely provide a written course of action, I shall evaluate it to determine if it is a reasonable attempt at abating the nuisance activity. You will receive a written response whether your proposed course of action is accepted or rejected. If accepted, you will have 45 days from the date of that notice of acceptance to implement the course of action.

If you propose a course of action that is rejected by me or you fail to timely respond to this request and a subsequent nuisance activity occurs on or after 13 days after receipt of this notice, or if you timely appeal this notice of nuisance premises and this nuisance premises determination is affirmed, the premises will be subject to placement of a special charge as a lien on the property by the Commissioner of the Department of Neighborhood Services for the cost of any police services and enforcement related to nuisance activity. The course of action plan should not include eviction unless you can demonstrate the likely ineffectiveness of other abatement actions. When investigating nuisance activity, remember that tenants with disabilities and victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking may be protected by the federal Fair Housing Act and Wisconsin's Open Housing Law.

It is highly recommended that you obtain records relating to police responses regarding the premises. You may obtain these records from the Computer Aided Dispatch System (CADS) at the Open Records Section of the Milwaukee Police Department (District Three Station, 2333 North 49th Street, Second Floor) between 8:00 AM and 3:45 PM. There is a cost of 25 cents per page for these records.

Please review the following examples of nuisance abatement measures that you may include in your written course of action to abate the nuisance activity. These suggestions are not exclusive, may not apply to the particular premises, and you may propose other nuisance abatement measures that would be appropriate under your particular circumstances.

- Participate in the Department of Neighborhood Services' Landlord Training Program and make a good faith effort to apply the knowledge from the course and attend refresher classes. Information on this training program may be obtained by calling (414) 286-2954.
- Exchange names and telephone numbers with the owners and operators of neighboring premises.
- Participate in a local block watch, neighborhood association, landlord compact and property management association.
- Attend the monthly crime prevention meetings conducted by the local Milwaukee Police District Community Liaison Officer who can be contacted at CLO Phone Number.
- Institute the use of written screening criteria that are provided to each applicant at the time each proposed adult resident receives a written application, and conduct background checks of all prospective adult tenants and residents.
- Institute the use of a written lease for each adult tenant that includes provisions relating to disorderly behavior, noise, garbage disposal, use of common areas, illegal activity, tenant

responsibility for guest conduct, and the prohibition of sub-leasing and long-term guests. Timely enforce any lease violations.

- Review the tenancies of all the current residents in the property.
- Regularly inspect the interior of the property to confirm that the residents are your tenants, confirm that the premises are actually used as a residence, and determine if the doors and windows have been fortified or the premises outfitted with surveillance or delivery mechanisms.
- Monitor the property for evidence of drug activity. This may include observation of clear corner cuts of baggies strewn about, excessive quantities of plastic sandwich baggies found in odd places, presence of numerous weight scales or communication devices and drug paraphernalia such as unusual pipes, empty cigar wrappers, burned hollow tubes, etc.
- Install "No Loitering" signs in the front and rear of the exterior of the property. This signage permits police to cite loitering individuals in the yard and sidewalk area.
- Install "No Trespassing" signs in the front and rear of the exterior of the property.
- Install a sign with your name and contact information in a common area requesting law enforcement to contact you if they are responding to a call for service at the premises.
- Record all rental properties owned by you with the Department of Neighborhood Services as required by local ordinance.
- Participate in the E-Notify system for email updates regarding the premises.
- Regularly file open records requests for Milwaukee Police Department Computer Aided Dispatch System (CADS) reports regarding the property.
- Institute a standing complaint with the local Milwaukee Police district station that will allow the police department to remove any individuals loitering on the property.
- Draft and serve a no trespassing order against identified nuisance persons and provide the local police district station a copy of the served order.
- Provide the local police district station with a current tenant list.
- Ensure that all tenants are aware of the Milwaukee Police Department's non-emergency number (414-933-4444) and are aware of when its use is appropriate.
- If there is conflict between tenants, offer transfers to different rental units.
- Install safety, crime-preventing equipment in common areas, such as cameras, motion detecting lights and improved locks.
- Make repairs to windows, doors and lights and improve landscaping.
- Routinely check vacant units for break-ins and trespassers.

Pursuant to MCO 80-10-7, it is unlawful for a landlord to terminate the lease agreement or periodic tenancy of any tenant or otherwise retaliate against any tenant because that tenant complained to the Milwaukee Police Department about nuisance activities on the landlord's premises. Any person found in violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$2,000.00 for each violation and in default of payment thereof, be imprisoned in the county jail or house of correction for a period of not less than 4 days nor more than 80 days.

Once you have been billed for the costs of police services and enforcement for three or more separate nuisance activities within one year of the date of this notice of nuisance premises, the premises may be designated a chronic nuisance, pursuant to MCO 80-10-6, and each and every

subsequent incident of nuisance activity at the premises may be deemed a separate violation and result in a citation being issued to you for failure to abate the nuisance activity. Each citation would subject you to a forfeiture of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$5,000.00. Upon default of payment of a chronic nuisance citation you would be subject to imprisonment in the county jail or house of correction for a period of not less than 40 days or more than 90 days for each violation.

This supplemental report was submitted by Detective Jonathan BOHN, assigned to the Gun Violence Division, Early Shift.

On 08/19/24, I was assigned to Squad 9240. Lt. ZOLO instructed me to respond to a shooting at 4937 N. 39th St.

I interviewed F M. C, (h/f,). The following is a synopsis of the interview of C

C stated that D (victim D C. D, b/m, is her fiancé. C stated that a black 2020 Ford F150 is going to get transferred to her. C stated Ji S/ (Ji D. S -Rf w/m, is her ex-boyfriend and the vehicle is currently under the name of L (L C. S w/f,

C stated that Juan has a new girlfriend S (S: L. W. b/f,). C stated that on Friday, August 16th, 2024, she and J. were in the vehicle. C stated that W. needed a ride home, so she exited the vehicle and W. entered. C stated that in the morning of Saturday, August 17th, J showed up looking for W. C stated that J had said that there was a problem with the battery to the vehicle, and he had left it at "S: a's Uncle's" residence (unknown name or location). C stated that she believed him, and noted that there indeed was an issue with the vehicle's battery. C stated that J called who she believed was the uncle, and they told him the vehicle was not there.

C stated earlier in the day on the incident date, August 19th, at approximately 12:30 PM, she, J, and D were walking to the McDonald's at N. Teutonia Ave. / W. Villard Ave. C stated they had spotted the same Ford F150 vehicle traveling eastbound on W. Villard Ave. C stated that J had ran ahead, and she observed the vehicle pull into the McDonald's parking lot.

C stated by the time she and D got to the McDonald's, J was talking to the driver, unknown what he was saying. C stated she observed that the driver was an unknown black male, late 30s to early 40s, with medium complexion. C stated the driver never exited the vehicle. C stated that also in the vehicle was the front passenger, an unknown black female in her early 40s, the rear driver's seat, an unknown black male, and the rear passenger's seat, an unknown black female.

C stated that she told the driver to give her the truck. C stated that D had also said to give his girlfriend's truck back. C stated that the driver said "Shut the fuck up. You ain't getting your truck." C stated that the driver then drove away, almost hitting them.

C stated they ended up not making any purchase at McDonald's. C stated afterwards, she and D had walked to J's residence at 5437 Bethmaur Ln., where she got a suitcase of hers. C stated that they stayed at Juan's residence for approximately 8 minutes, and then walked back to the residence 4937 N. 39th St.

C stated she and D had been hanging out in an empty apartment on the ground floor of the apartment complex. C stated sometime between approximately 3:30 PM and 3:40 PM, a newer white truck, unknown make/model, with tinted side windows and no tint on the back window, had arrived at the residence, which she could observe through the blinds of the window at the apartment. C stated the vehicle parked on N. 39th St. directed towards N. Hopkins St. C stated 4 people got out, including W and 3 black males. C stated that the males all had firearms on their person in their waistband area, displaying them in such a fashion as to be visible. C recognized 2 of the males to be the same that she observed were in the Ford F150 at McDonald's. C stated the subjects went in the hallway area, and she could hear them going upstairs (it should be noted that Unit 9, C's residence is upstairs). C stated that "100%" these subjects were there for them. C stated they stayed quiet and eventually the subjects came outside and got in the vehicle and left.

C stated approximately 30 minutes later, they were still in the lower unit. C stated that D had told her that her truck was there. C stated she had observed the black Ford F150 truck make a loop around the block and parked in front of the residence facing away from N.

Hopkins St. C/ stated 3 subjects had exited the vehicle, including the shooter, which she believed had come from the rear passenger's side seat. C/ stated the shooter was a black male, late 30s, medium complexion, approximately 5'8"-5'9", approximately 200 pounds, wearing a black or grey hooded sweatshirt with the hood up, believed to be tied, black pants, and gray handgun. C/ stated that one of the other subjects was a black male with a yellow shirt, no other descriptors, and the third subject was a black male, no other descriptors.

C/ stated that the shooter had exited the vehicle with the firearm pointing it at both her and D/ while they were by the doorway. C/ stated that the subject had said "What was that bullshit you were saying earlier" and had said how they were acting tough earlier. C/ stated that she said please don't shoot, and also that they could have the truck. C/ stated that the shooter turned around for a second, and then turned back around and that's when he started shooting. C/ stated she heard 4-5 shots and she observed muzzle flashes coming from the shooter's firearm.

C/ stated that after the shooting, the vehicle went south and then believed it made a left hand turn onto W. Stark Ave. C/ stated she observed that D/ was shot and she called 911. C/ stated that D/ kept going in and out of consciousness. C/ stated that she observed W/ after the shooting, but didn't observe her during the shooting at all.

 Suspect vehicle processing via search warrant.

This supplemental report is written by Detective Ryan Kramschuster, assigned to the Criminal Investigations Bureau - Gun Violence Division, Early Shift (4:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.), Squad 9253.

On Wednesday, 8-21-24, at about 6:00 p.m., at the City of Milwaukee Tow Lot Z-Building at 3811 W. Lincoln Av., Milwaukee, WI, I searched and processed - via the authority of a search warrant and for evidence particular to MPD non-fatal shooting case #C2408190107, CAD #P2408191065 - a black 2020 Ford F150, with WI registration plate # MK3594 and VIN# 1FTEW1E46LFA96823.

Background: This offense (a non-fatal shooting) occurred on Monday, 8-19-24, at about 4:17 p.m., at 4937 N. 39th St, Milwaukee, WI, wherein Milwaukee Police officers responded to multiple 911 call-in reports that a shooting had just occurred outside of and in front of the multi-unit residential apartment building at 4937 N. 39th St., Milwaukee, WI; that officers shortly thereafter arrived and discovered: (a) victim D D (M/B,) with a life-threatening (through-and-through) gunshot injury to his chest, (b) a grouping of three (3) 9mm casings in the roadway in front that residence, and (c) several witnesses to the shooting; that via initial witness statements, it was indicated that the shooter(s) (who had fled the scene prior to the arrival of investigators) had both arrived to and fled in a black Ford F150; moreover, that D was medically transported to Froedtert Hospital for emergency surgery and had not provided a statement as to the circumstances of the incident;

(1) That during the course of the initial scene investigation, witness F C stated to Det. Jonathan Bohn that she is the victim's current girlfriend, and that the vehicle that the suspect's used for both the ingress and egress to the area (a black Ford F150), is supposed to have legal ownership transferred to herself, and that the vehicle is currently registered to "L", who is the spouse of C's ex-boyfriend, J S; that J S - however being in a relationship with L - has a current girlfriend, S W; that on Friday (about three days prior to the shooting), C was along with J S in the F150, when - due to an apparent issue with the vehicle's battery - they left it at S W's uncle's residence at an unknown location; that upon returning for the vehicle the following day, it was no longer where they had left it and was presumed - however, not reported - as stolen;

(2) That C further stated that, earlier today (8-19-24), at about 12:30 p.m., herself, D and Juan S. were walking together near a McDonald's restaurant, on W. Villard Av., in Milwaukee; that they observed the F150 at the McDonald's; that J and C confronted the driver, at which time the driver stated "Shut the fuck up, you ain't getting your truck", then left while still operating the F150; that at about 4:17 p.m., while C was along with D outside of and in front of 4937 N. 39th St., the F150 stopped in front of the residence, at which time three black males exited the F150, including the shooter (M/B, late 30s, medium complexion, 5'8"-5'9", 200lbs, black or grey hooded sweatshirt with the hood up, possible black pants, and a grey firearm) who intentionally pointed a handgun at both C and D, and stated "What was that bullshit you were saying earlier" and "You were acting tough earlier", then - following a brief exchange of words - the suspect intentionally and with utter disregard for D's life, discharged multiple handgun rounds at D, causing his gunshot injury; moreover, that the F150 then fled southbound.

(3) That during the course of the initial scene investigation, a WI DOT records check revealed a black 2020 Ford F150, with WI registration plate # MK3594 and VIN# 1FTEW1E46LFA96823, registered to owner Layla Santana out of Milwaukee; that a Be on the Look Out (BOLO) as well as Felony Vehicle Want was placed on that particular vehicle regarding this particular crime.

(4) That on 8-20-24 (the following day), the above-referenced vehicle (a black 2020 Ford F150, with WI registration plate # MK3594 and VIN# 1FTEW1E46LFA96823), Milwaukee Police officers - having knowledge of the details of the above-referenced BOLO - discovered this vehicle unoccupied and parked in a rear parking lot at 9102 W. Allen St., Milwaukee, WI; that those officers remained with the vehicle while having it towed as evidence to the Milwaukee Police Department Z-Building at the City of Milwaukee Tow Lot at 3811 W. Lincoln Av., Milwaukee, WI, as referenced via tow #2471656.

Copy uploaded to evidence.com under ID # P2408191065.

Forensic Investigator Gagnon documented this vehicle search/evidence processing via photographs, and fully processed the vehicle for DNA and fingerprint evidence. Refer to supplemental reports regarding.

The following evidence was discovered and recovered as:

This supplemental report is written by Detective Ryan Kramschuster, assigned to the Criminal Investigations Bureau - Gun Violence Division, Early Shift (4:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.), Squad 9253.

On Monday, 8-19-24, at about 5:20 p.m, I responded to the scene of a non-fatal shooting (NFS) investigation at 4937 N. 39th St, Milwaukee, WI, as referenced via MPD NFS case #C2408190107, Computer Aided Dispatch #P2408191065.

Background: This offense (a non-fatal shooting) occurred on Monday, 8-19-24, at about 4:17 p.m., at 4937 N. 39th St, Milwaukee, WI, wherein Milwaukee Police officers responded to multiple 911 call-in reports that a shooting had just occurred outside of and in front of the multi-unit residential apartment building at 4937 N. 39th St, Milwaukee, WI; that officers shortly thereafter arrived and discovered: (a) victim D. D. (M/B,) with a life-threatening (through-and-through) gunshot injury to his chest, (b) a grouping of three (3) 9mm casings in the roadway in front that residence, and (c) several witnesses to the shooting; that via initial witness statements, it was indicated that the shooter(s) (who had fled the scene prior to the arrival of investigators) had both arrived to and fled in a black Ford F150; moreover, that D. D. was medically transported to Froedtert Hospital for emergency surgery and had not provided a statement as to the circumstances of the incident.

Initial investigation witness interviews contemporaneous to the scene investigation:

Interview with witness L. W. (F/B,

W. confirmed her personal information, stating that she resides at 2849 N. 2nd St, Milwaukee, WI, that she has a cellular phone number of [redacted] and that GSWV D. D. is her son. Regarding events preceding the shooting, W. stated that she was visiting at 4937 N. 39th St., in apartment #9; that she heard an argument outside, about which she looked out of the front room second-level window (that overlooks N. 39th St.) and observed her son's black Ford F-150—a vehicle that she believed had apparently recently been stolen and/or possibly retained during the course of having been loaned in exchange for drugs - stopped in the roadway and facing south; and that the following three unknown suspects were standing outside of the vehicle:

- Suspect 1 (S1/Shooter): M/B, about 30yoa, about 508, thin build, dark complexion, wearing a black mask covering his face, a black hooded sweatshirt with the hood up, black pants, and armed with a black semi-automatic handgun.
- Suspect 2 (S2): M/B, about 30yoa, "taller" than S1, long black braided hair, no mask, all dark clothing.
- Suspect 3 (S3): M/B, about 30yoa, about 508, black baseball hat with orange writing/design, no mask, all dark clothing.

W. stated that, also standing outside (nearby to each other) at about the public sidewalk nearest the window where she (W.) was looking out, was her son (D. D.) and his girlfriend, "K "; that S1, with S2 and S3 standing behind him, was pointing a handgun at D. D. and indicating his intention to shoot D. D. via stating, "N[—], I'ma shoot you. I'll blow you brains out." W. stated that she (W.) yelled to S1 not to do it.

W. stated that all parties then began to walk away, at which time S1 turned around and stated, "I'ma do it anyway," then S1 intentionally directed his firearm at D. D. and discharged round(s) at and into D. D. that S1, S2, and S3 immediately entered the black Ford F150 (in uncertain seating positions) and fled southbound, having briefly stopped at the first intersection to drop off female passenger "S- " (who was wearing an olive drab sweatshirt and who had not exited the vehicle during the course of the shooting), then continued away in the F-150 believedly southbound.

Weese stated that she then went outside to D. D. , wherein she observed his gunshot injury and remained with him until police arrived.

Due to Wi [redacted] having not made any prior indications to investigators that she had also witnessed this event, her having been seated next to L [redacted] Wi [redacted] at that time of that interview, and her having only revealed that information at about the conclusion of that interview, her statement of events was a brief confirmation of what W [redacted] had stated—as she (W. [redacted]) had also been visiting apartment #9 and witnessed the shooting from the same window as Wi [redacted] at the same time as W [redacted].

Wi [redacted], in addition to confirming W [redacted]'s statement, stated that (due to S2 and S3 having not been wearing face coverings), she would likely be able to later identify them via photo array.

On October 3, 2024 at 6:33 am, I conducted an in-custody interview of S L W (B/F, The interview was conducted on the 4th floor of the Police Administration Building room 425G, which has audio and video recording. I started the recording at 6:33 am prior to retrieving W/ I located W in holding cell Q5 of Central Booking. I escorted W/ to room 425G and began the interview at 6:40 am. I provided W with a State of Wisconsin Department of Justice Constitutional Rights card as I read W Miranda verbatim from the card at 6:40 am. The following is a brief account of the interview, for a full account the interview can be view in its entirety on evidence.com.

It has been my experience that during interviews, the participants do not always explain events or details in chronological order. In a question and answer type conversation some details are revealed in pieces, only to be clarified later through further questioning and recall. The below summary is to place the information in an organized account of the interviewee's information so that a reader can make sense of the events that took place.

W/ stated the truck belonged to a Hispanic male and was a drug rental. W stated she was in the truck earlier on the day of the shooting. W stated she was dropped off before the shooting happened. W/ stated she was in the truck with 2 other guys she has only met 3 times before, at the gas station on Villard and Hopkins. W stated she only knows them as "C" and "T".

W/ stated "C" was a B/M in his 30's, 5'6"-5'7", stocky build, light complected, short hair, last seen wearing a white t-shirt and white baseball style hat. "T" was a B/M in his 20's, 6' skinny, dark complected, dreads down to his shoulders, last seen wearing a black hoody. W/ stated "T" was the driver and "C" was the front passenger in the truck. W stated she did not see either of them with a gun. W stated they both sold drugs, cocaine.

W stated she did not know anything about the shooting. W stated she heard gunshots and went over to see what happened. W/ stated she talked to the police and then left.

I ended the interview at 7:00 am and returned W to her holding cell. I ended the recording at 7:00 am. No breaks were taken during the interview and W was given a glass of water.

Al JR, B/M, who sustained numerous gunshot wounds over his body and was located in MED5 and despite life savings measures was pronounced deceased at 3:16 PM by DR. 0004. Victim #2 was identified as St F. F B/F, who sustained a gunshot wound to her left arm and was conveyed to Froedtert for medical treatment by MED2 and was admitted at 3:25 PM and treated by DR. Casings and cartridges were located in the road way, along the sidewalk, and a pool of blood was located in the road way and a trail was observed leading north. I took measurements based off a reference point (R.P.) from the City of Milwaukee Street light located on the west side of the street near the north end of the apartment building with the address of 4909 N 39th ST. I took measurements using my department issued Bosch brand laser distance meter. All measurements are approximate.

The Victim

Upon my arrival to the scene ALLEN was located in the rear of Milwaukee Fire Department MED 5 and had numerous bullet wounds all over his body. ALLEN's clothes were cut, removed, and placed in a bag which was saturated with blood and to be transported with ALLEN to the Medical Examiner's Office. ALLEN was not in possession of a cell phone, wallet, or any form of ID on his person's.

I recovered then all of the located evidence. I requested that the Jeep Compass to be towed to the evidence building as an evidence tow # 2488303. The vehicle was towed to the city of Milwaukee tow lot for further processing. I then conveyed all of the recovered evidence to the Police Administration Building and placed the items on Milwaukee Police Department Inventory # 24029171.

This report is written by Detective Michael DRISCOLL who is assigned to the Criminal Investigation Bureau, Homicide Division Early Shift.

On Saturday, October 12th, 2024, I was assigned to respond to 4909 N. 39th St in the City of Milwaukee to assist with the investigation of the fatal shooting that occurred in front of the residence at 2:45 P.M.

I arrived on scene and was advised that two people were shot after a fight between two females. One of the victims, identified as E. A. JR. (B/M) was pronounced deceased at the scene. The second victim, identified as S. F. (B/F), was shot and conveyed to Froedtert Hospital with a non-fatal gunshot wound to her left arm.

I was assigned to conduct witness interviews regarding the fatal shooting. One of the witness who remained on scene was identified as P. N. E. (B/F)

E. was standing in front of the residence at 4937 N. 39th. E. knows that a woman she knows as "St" has been fighting people all day because she believes someone stole her

property. E. knows that S. lives at 4937 N. 39th St #10.

E. reported that S' called her daughters to the address to fight another woman she only knows as "S' " regarding the stolen clothes.

E. observed as a fight between females started in front of the residence.

E. observed S ; "baby daddy", sho only knows as " " come out of the front entrance to the apartment at 4937 N. 39th St with a gun. E. stated ' then shot one round at the mother, who she call "C' two rounds at the daughter who was fighting and 3 plus round into the male V causing his death.

then came back towards the front of the address where she was standing and she thought he was going to shoot her, so she told him to run. E. then observed run west behind the apartment complex with a gun in his hand.

E. was sure that S was in close proximity to when he was shooting the victim.

Investigation at the scene revealed that S' was positively identified as M S. W B/F 7/28/1981, 4937 N. 39th St #10. W' was detained at the scene and interviewed by myself and Detective SOKOLOWSKI. M S. W' was previously booked by the Milwaukee Police Department as Meshaka S. W

Interview of M i S. W

W' was interviewed about the incident and reported that she called her sister and her niece to her residence to fight a B/F named "S " because W' thought S stole clothes from her apartment.

When W' 'S sister and niece arrived on scene they fought S in front of the residence. W claimed to be breaking up the fight when she heard gunshots behind her that struck the victim. W' stated she did not know who did the shooting.

I advised W that we were conducting an Official Homicide investigation and that being untruthful to the Police could lead to her being arrested for Obstructing an Officer. I further advised W' that we have already talked to other witnesses regarding this case.

W' repeated that she did not know who was shooting because they were standing behind her. W' admitted to knowing " ", reporting that she has dated him in the past and that he was on site at the time of the fight.

W' was found to be intentionally giving false information with intent to mislead Detectives in the performance of their duty.

W' was taken into custody at the scene and conveyed to Central Booking for Processing.

Later W' did admit that she knows and gave Detectives a truthful statement.

W stated that she woke up at approx. 1pm on 10/12/2024. She confronted S about her missing items. There was then a verbal argument between the two regarding. W claimed that due to her [redacted] she was too weak to fight, so she called her (b/f, [redacted]) who was supposed to call [redacted] who is the [redacted]



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daughter of W. but instead came to 4909 N 39th St. with her mother C (who is the sister of M). During this interaction C and S begin to argue in the middle of the street and per W, C "muffs" S. At this time the fight breaks up and everyone goes their separate ways.

Approx. 20 min later while W was at her apartment by herself, S's daughter and S's daughter's boyfriend came to W's apartment. During this interaction S's daughter demanded to know who hit her mother. W told them that the fight was between S and C. They demanded that W contact C and bring her back to the scene (which she does).

It should be noted that C returns to the scene in her [redacted]'s daughter and [redacted]'s boyfriend. He was described as a **b/m. 18-21. med complexion 6'0-6'01"**.

[redacted]. It should be noted that this would be a possible second shooter during the homicide.

and S's daughter then begin to physically fight in the middle of the roadway. W stated that K was winning the fight and that S's daughter's boyfriend pulled out a firearm and started to point it at everyone. The fight then broke up and he then pointed the gun at C and racked the gun. W believed that he was going to shoot C but before he did she saw [redacted]'s boyfriend (unknown real name, but described above) shoot approx. 3 times in the direction of E. A (deceased victim). W stated that A fell to the ground immediately and then [redacted] (W's boyfriend) shot A while he was on the ground. When asked why [redacted] shoot A while he was on the ground. W stated that A kept on trying to shoot his gun even while on the ground after being shot.

W then stated that people started to run and that S took the gun from A (theft from corpse) and shot at W 2-3 times and then fled with the firearm.

WOLFE stated that she does not know where [redacted] ran to and stated that C, K and Kayvonna's boyfriend left in C's vehicle ([redacted]).

During the QP W was shown three photos, a photo of [redacted] (has known for approx 15 yrs), C W (sister of W) and F D (has known for approx 4 months, lives in the same apartment). W ID all three photos regarding.

I ended the interview at approx 12:24 am. W received three cigarettes during the course of the QP. W was returned to Central Booking and subsequently conveyed to CJF regarding.


