Resolution #010486 is a substitute resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a 2002 Recycling grant.

## **BACKGROUND & DISCUSSION**

- 1. The Department of Public Works (DPW) annually submits a resolution to authorize DPW to apply for and accept and fund the continuation of the current recycling grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
- 2. State statutes currently specify the maximum amount that may be appropriated for the state's recycling grant program for all municipalities. Between 1994 and 1997, the maximum available was \$28,000,000 annually. In 1998, the appropriation level dropped 18% to \$24,000,000. The 2002 State of Wisconsin Budget continues to fund the recycling grant program at this level.
- 3. The amount of \$2,800,495 was granted to the City of Milwaukee in 2001.
- 4. DPW estimates the State will provide \$2,800,495 in 2002 for the recycling program. The City's share of recycling cost is estimated to be \$7,273,906 of the total cost of recycling of \$10,074,401.
- 5. DPW does not anticipate any significant change to service levels in 2002.
- 6. DPW currently operates 31 cart routes and 4 weekly bin routes servicing approximately 193,000 residences. The Department annually collects approximately 30,000 tons curbside recyclable. In addition, DPW's recycling program annually collects approximately 30,000 tons of brush and leaves.

## FISCAL IMPACT

1. The resolution authorizes the acceptance of \$2,800,495 for the recycling program's grant and aids account.
