File No. 041491 is a resolution relative to the acceptance and funding of a Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources grant to support public information and education projects related to storm water management.

## **Background and Discussion**

- 1. The City is eligible to receive a competitive Urban Nonpoint Source and Storm Water Management Program Planning grant.
- 2. Eligible activities include:
  - Urban runoff control planning activities
  - Urban runoff control implementation activities
  - Public participation, education, and outreach activities
- 3. The City plans to use the funding to develop and implement public information and education projects related to storm water management to achieve the following:
  - Water quality standards
  - Minimize flooding
  - Protect groundwater
  - Coordinate urban nonpoint source management activities with the municipal storm sewer discharge permit program authorized under s. 283.33, Stats.
  - Implement non-agricultural nonpoint source performance standards authorized under s. 281.16(2), Stats.
- 4. The grant operates from January 1, 2005 to December 31, 2006.

## Fiscal Impact

- 1. Adopting File 041491 authorized the acceptance and expenditure of a \$25,000 planning grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Urban Nonpoint Source and Storm Water Management Program.
- 2. This grant requires a city match of \$25,000.
