File No. 041491 is a resolution relative to the acceptance and funding of a Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources grant to support public information and education projects related to storm water management.

**Background and Discussion**

1. The City is eligible to receive a competitive Urban Nonpoint Source and Storm Water Management Program Planning grant.
2. Eligible activities include:
  - Urban runoff control planning activities
  - Urban runoff control implementation activities
  - Public participation, education, and outreach activities
3. The City plans to use the funding to develop and implement public information and education projects related to storm water management to achieve the following:
  - Water quality standards
  - Minimize flooding
  - Protect groundwater
  - Coordinate urban nonpoint source management activities with the municipal storm sewer discharge permit program authorized under s. 283.33, Stats.
  - Implement non-agricultural nonpoint source performance standards authorized under s. 281.16(2), Stats.
4. The grant operates from January 1, 2005 to December 31, 2006.

**Fiscal Impact**

1. Adopting File 041491 authorized the acceptance and expenditure of a \$25,000 planning grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Urban Nonpoint Source and Storm Water Management Program.
2. This grant requires a city match of \$25,000.
