There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

I live in your district on I and have heard troubling reports about Axel's Inn on Oakland Ave for a couple of years now. I myself also have had a not so nice experience there and just wanted to make you aware of this.

Mainly through the neighborhood pages on FB, but also very recently on Google reviews, women have reported their drinks being spiked at this bar. Several years ago, I believe I also was drugged at this bar and have since not returned. I would hope that the police have been notified of complaints, but if not I would like to do something/alert someone to make sure that these allegations are known to someone within the necessary channels.

10. On 02/23/21 at 7:37pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 2859 N. Oakland Avenue. The staff was cooperative and helpful and no violations were found.

11. On 02/25/22, officers were dispatched to 2859 N. Oakland Av., for a Sick and Injured Person. Investigation revealed two patrons who were underage were found to be in possession of fake id's and had consumed alcohol at the establishment. The agent was on scene and asked officers for suggestions to stop this from occurring again. The agent was cooperative during the investigation.

12. On 04/21/22, officers were dispatched to 2859 N. Oakland av., for a Tavern Violation. Investigation revealed there were numerous patrons under the legal drinking age in the bar. Some of which had fake id's, however, some of the patrons stated they did not have identification and were not asked by the bouncer. The agent was on scene and cooperative with the investigation and requested ID Training for his employees to avoid repeating the violations.

13. On 04/28/22, officers conducted an Underage Tavern Enforcement at 2859 N. Oakland Av., utilizing police aides. Security did request identification from the police aides, therefore, the police aides did not gain access to the establishment.

14. On 02/23/23 at 11:54p.m., officers conducted an Underage Tavern Enforcement at 2859 N. Oakland Av. Investigation revealed there were numerous patrons that appeared and admitted to being underage. Some patrons stated they walked right past the bouncer without being asked to provide identification, and others stated they were friends with the bouncer and that's how they gained entry. Multiple citations were issued to patrons for Misrepresenting Age to Receive Alcohol. An announcement was made for all individuals to leave the premise if they were underage or had a fake ID. At that time, approximately 40 individuals left the bar. The bouncer stated they scanned everyone's ID and no one was allowed without ID. The agent was on scene and very cooperative with the investigation.

15. On 03/16/23 at 8:30p.m., Milwaukee Police along with Department of Revenue Alcohol and Tobacco, conducted a License Premise Check at 2859 N. Oakland Av. Investigation

revealed there were no invoices for Alcohol on premises, however, the DOR Agent advised the agent they would allow them a few days to email the invoices. Three open bottles of alcohol were contaminated and the agent was advised to dump the alcohol and deface the bottles. Further inspection showed a dirty sticky funnel in the storage area where alcohol is stored. The DOR Agent stated this was commonly known to be used to refill alcohol bottles. The agent was on scene and advised of the violations and stated the funnel was used for cleaning. The officer was going to submit a request to the Health Department to conduct an inspection due to the observations of the bar being dirty, and the concerns of bugs in alcohol bottles.

16. On 08/29/23 at 2:31a.m, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 2859 N. Oakland Av. Investigation revealed an intoxicated patron became angry after being told they smelled of body odor, and began to smash glasses on the bar. The agent stated they had to grab the patron's arm to stop them from smashing more glasses. The patron then directed their anger toward a friend cleaning glasses behind the bar, and threw a glass at them, causing a laceration that required sutures. The patron was arrested on scene. The agent was cooperative with the investigation, however, did smell of intoxicants.
17. On 010/12/23 at 8:22p.m., officers conducted an Underage Tavern Enforcement at 2859 N. Oakland Av., utilizing police aides. Security did request identification from the police aides, therefore, the police aides did not gain access to the establishment.

This report is written by PO Kara PLACZEK, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift. On Thursday, February 23rd, 2023, I was assigned to Squad 1431 with PO Jeremy KENNER. PO KENNER and I were dressed in our full Milwaukee Police Department issued uniforms with our nameplates and badges affixed to our outermost garments. PO KENNER and I were wearing our Milwaukee Police Department issued Body Worn Cameras (BWC) at the time of this investigation.

At approximately 11:54 PM, Squad 1431, along with Squad 1412 (Sgt. SCHEURING), 1290 (PO LEE), 1410 (Sgt. SCHWANDT), 1411 (Sgt. KULENOVIC), 1163 (PO MUSTAFA and PO PLUMLEY), 1421 (PO CHADWICK and PO ZAVADIL), and 1440 (PO DELANEY and PO SWITZER), conducted a tavern check at the address of 2859 N. Oakland Ave., Axels Inn.

PO ZAVADIL, PO SWITZER, PO CHADWICK, and PO DELANEY observed several individuals who appeared to be under the legal age and verbally admitted to being underage. The officers issued citations for misrepresenting age to receive alcohol to these individuals. See Citation #'s 06817LCTMM, J981TOLHKP, J981TOLHK0, 0681KLCTK9, 0681KLCTK8, 0681KLCTK7, 0681KLCTK6, 0681LTDXXF, and J981CMCGHS regarding. A few of the individuals stated they walked past the bouncer without being asked to provide identification. Then, a group of individuals, possibly 40 individuals, left the location after officers gave a verbal warning to leave the premises if they were underage or had a fake ID. The individuals were given a warning that they were going to get detained and cited if they were caught.

The owner/agent, Eric A. RASMUSSEN (w/m, 03-14-1970) was issued a citation for allowing underage on the premises. See citation #06817LCTMN regarding.

Several of the subjects receiving citations stated they were friends with the bouncer and that's how they were allowed entry into the tavern.

I spoke with security/front doorman, Jonathan J. DUMMANN (w/m, 09-19-2001). DUMMANN stated he was the only security guard working that night. DUMMANN stated he scanned everyone's Identification Card/Driver's License who entered the bar. DUMMANN stated everyone who was inside the bar was cleared by the ID scanner. DUMMANN stated no one was allowed in the bar who did not have an ID. DUMMANN stated they do not use metal detectors or conduct pat downs.

I was able to observe that all licenses were up to date and properly displayed for public view. I observed an ID scanner by the entrance.

I also spoke with the bartender, Brady D. BECK (w/m, 12-06-1999). BECK stated no one is let inside the bar without being cleared by the ID scanner at the entrance.

RASMUSSEN and the rest of the staff provided all information that was requested and were very cooperative.

On Thursday, March 16th, 2023, while assigned to Squad #1164 I, along with PO EMMONS, PO MUSTAFA, SGT SCHWANDT (sq#1410), SGT SCHEURING (sq#1412), SGT KULENOVIC (sq#1411), PO DELANEY (sq#1440), and PO SWITZER (sq#1440) assisted the Department of Revenue (Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement) on three separate tavern inspections in the Milwaukee Police District One boundaries. Agent SCHNERING, Ashley led the deployment with the assistance of Agent SCHLEIS, Derrick.

At approximately 8:30 PM we conducted an inspection at 2859 N. Oakland Av (Axels). Upon our arrival we were greeted by RASMUSSEN, Eric A (W/M 3/14/1970) who is the listed agent of the tavern. Agent SCHLEIS informed RASMUSSEN that we would be conducting an investigation. Agent SCHNERING informed me that there were no invoices for the alcohol being served on premises, but did give RASMUSSEN permission to email the invoices within the next few days showing that all purchases were from wholesalers. During the inspection three open contaminated bottles were located behind the bar. The contaminated bottles appeared to have fruit fly's / bugs floating in them. RASMUSSEN was informed that he would need to dispose of the alcohol in the bottle and deface the empty bottles. During the inspection Agents SCHLEIS and SCHNERING discovered a white funnel that appeared dirty and sticky from being used, kept in the alcohol storage area. Agent SCHNERING informed me of their findings and that it was common to find a funnel in establishments that illegally refill liquor bottles. I informed Agent SCHNERING that it was concerning for the bottles to be refilled because we don't know what they are being refilled with and UW Milwaukee has had an increase in students getting sick and they are not sure what is causing it. Axels is located near the UW Milwaukee Campus and is frequented by UW Milwaukee students. Agent SCHNERING asked RASMUSSEN what the funnel was used for and he informed her it was used for cleaning. Agent SCHNERING informed RASMUSSEN of the dangers that come with refilling bottles and that it was illegal to do so. This completed the inspection.

I will be asking the Health Department to possibly do an inspection of this establishment. My observation was that the bar was dirty, with sticky bar tops, the handling of food/garnishments for drinks did not appear to be adequate, and the concern of bugs in alcohol bottles.

On 8-29-23 at 2:31AM while assigned to Squad 1322, I was dispatched to a Battery Cutting Complaint at Axel's Bar, located at 2859 N Oakland Av. PO Kareem SLOANS (Sq 1390) also responded.

It should be noted the original dispatched location was 2059 N Oakland Av and was determined to be an error. The CAD stated the caller was assaulted by a customer who threw a shot glass at him and busted his lip. The caller further stated the suspect was still outside. The telecommunicator noted that the caller sounded intoxicated and made threats to shoot the suspect if he had a firearm at the time. Another party then called, stating he was assaulted by a customer with a knife. The knife was determined to be baseless.

I spoke with Eric A RASMUSSEN (W/M, 03-14-70) who stated he is the Business Agent/Bar Manager and the bar has been owned by his family since 1937. RASMUSSEN explained there was a patron in the bar that was consuming alcohol and approaching customers and engaging in conversation, but making most people uncomfortable. At one point, the patron consumed a shot and seemed as though he was going to vomit into his hands before running into the bathroom. The patron returned to the bar and approached another couple who asked him to leave them alone because he smelled of body odor. This angered the patron who then began smashing pint glasses on the bar top. RASMUSSEN stated he had to grab the patron's hands to keep him from damaging more items and making more of a disturbance.

RASMUSSEN stated his long-time friend was behind the bar, cleaning glasses and the patron then directed his anger towards his friend and threw a shot glass at him, striking him in the lip. The laceration would eventually require sutures to repair.

RASMUSSEN was cooperative during the process, but did show signs of consuming alcohol.

I observed surveillance cameras inside the building, but RASMUSSEN informed me that they do not record.

The patron was arrested.


