My name is Walter Chesser and I am the proprietor of MIL-TOWN Apparel and Printing) located at 3620 W. Villard Ave. And for the last 3 years I have been a board member and treasurer for Business Improvement District #19 Board, (BID) your business improvement district.

A meeting will be held noon Monday August 17, 2015 at the BID's office 3328 W Villard Ave. Milwaukee, Wisconsin. I believe this meeting is one you or a representative must attend. It is my opinion that the real purpose of this meeting is to:

1. to remove the treasurer without cause
2. retaliate against the treasurer for an email sent to the City of Milwaukee Mayor Tom Barrett (a dysfunctional BID)
3. approve a settlement of the treasurer's complaint that the BID violated the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law and to minimize the findings of the Office of Corporation Counsel, Milwaukee County, and
4. discredit the treasurer by inferring the treasurer made payments without the approval and full knowledge of the BID.
