File #050892 is a substitute resolution authorizing and directing the City Comptroller to create State and/or Federal Aid project sub accounts for preliminary engineering for the North 76<sup>th</sup> Street – West Center Street to West Appleton Avenue paving project and transfer funds for preliminary engineering.

## **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

- 1. This substitute resolution authorizes and directs the City Comptroller to create State and/or Federal Aid project sub accounts for preliminary engineering for the North 76<sup>th</sup> Street West Center Street to West Appleton Avenue paving project and transfer funds for preliminary engineering costs.
- 2. In Common Council File #041289, approved February 1, 2005, the "State/Municipal Agreement for a Highway Improvement Project" was executed with the Wisconsin Department Of Transportation (WISDOT) for the programming and construction of various highway and bridge projects with federal and/or state aid. The N. 76<sup>th</sup> Street (STH 181) from W. Center Street to W. Appleton Avenue project was included in the file.
- 3. In this resolution, the N. 76<sup>th</sup> Street (STH 181) from W. Center Street to W. Appleton Avenue project, located in the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic Districts, is scheduled for reconstruction in 2010 as part of the WISDOT Connecting Highway Program. The WISDOT has approved the executed agreement for the preliminary and construction costs for the project.
- 4. The project expects 75% Federal and/or State Aid for preliminary engineering costs. The Federal and/or State Aid for participating construction costs is expected at 88%, with the city share based on a ratio of an street parking permitted with some sidewalk and private driveway replacement costs as non-participating and funded 100% by the City.
- 5. The total estimated cost of the project is \$11,449,000, with the grantor share of \$9,721,000 with the city share of \$1,133,800. The total preliminary engineering costs are \$1,728,000.

## FISCAL IMPACT

- 1. The total estimated preliminary engineering costs for the N. 76<sup>th</sup> Street (STH 181), from W. Center Street to W. Appleton Ave. paving project is \$1,728,000 through the WISDOT Connecting Highway Program. The grantor share is \$1,296,000, 75%, and the city share is \$432,000, 25%.
- 2. The City funding is through the 2006 capital improvements fund, from the Paving Program-Street Reconstruction-City Contribution to State and Federally Aided Projects account.

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
