REASON FOR REQUEST:

David Letteer, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a marked police squad car that was traveling westbound on West Locust Street. As the City vehicle proceeded through the intersection of North 11th Street and West Locust Street, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling southbound on North 11th Street, disregarded the stop sign at the intersection of North 11th Street and West Locust Street, striking the City vehicle and causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Letteer sustained a concussion and injuries to his head, neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$21,141.37.
