
REASON FOR REQUEST:

David Letteer, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a marked police squad car that was traveling westbound on West Locust Street. As the City vehicle proceeded through the intersection of North 11<sup>th</sup> Street and West Locust Street, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling southbound on North 11<sup>th</sup> Street, disregarded the stop sign at the intersection of North 11<sup>th</sup> Street and West Locust Street, striking the City vehicle and causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Letteer sustained a concussion and injuries to his head, neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$21,141.37.
