REASON FOR REQUEST:

John Ambeau, Jr., a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City vehicle that was traveling southbound on Boundary Road. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of Boundary Road and Main Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding westbound on Main Street, failed to yield the right of way by disregarding the red traffic light, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Ambeau sustained injuries to his wrists, ankles, left hip, left shoulder, left knee, neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$33,197.91.
