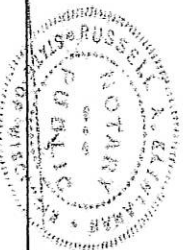

Substitute resolution approving levying of assessments and construction of assessable public improvement projects at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City cost of these projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$1,098,500 for a total estimated cost of \$1,167,000.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions, determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct and levy special assessments for the following improvements:

**7th Aldermanic District**  
**N. 54th Blvd. - W. Keeffe Ave. to W. Melvina St. (ST211150114) File Number 151739:** Concrete pavement reconstruction, replace all curb and gutter, replace sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (24-foot width of tree border area), and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$46,000; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$700,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$775,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2016 construction season.

**10th Aldermanic District**  
**Alley between W. Adler St., W. Main St., S. 72nd St., and S. 73rd St. (ST212160112) File Number 141725:** Concrete alley pavement reconstruction, and grading. (Assessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$26,500; Nonassessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$100,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$140,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2016 construction season.

**12th Aldermanic District**  
**W. Walker St. - S. 2nd St. to S. 3rd St. (ST211150184) File Number 141248:** Concrete pavement reconstruction, replace all curb and gutter, replace sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (10 - 12-foot width of tree border area), and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$7,500; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$150,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$170,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2016 construction season.

**Alley between W. Scott St., W. Washington St., S. 7th St., and S. 8th St. (ST212040117) File Number 151287:** Concrete alley pavement reconstruction, and grading. (Assessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$8,500; Nonassessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$60,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$82,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2016 construction season.

Whereas, The report of the Commissioner of Public Works has been filed with the City Clerk; and Whereas, Notices have been sent to all interested persons and public hearings held; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Commissioner of Public Works' Report, as amended at said Public Hearing, is approved and the properties therein identified are benefited; and, be it

Further Resolved, That said Commissioner of Public Works is authorized and directed to proceed with said work in accordance with said report pursuant to Section 66.0703 and any other pertinent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes and in the manner directed by

Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting or adjacent properties and collect such assessment in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as
